Remarks/Market Observations	<p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of April:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Overall, sufficient supply of fresh marine commodities were noted among the monitored retail markets this month. However, lesser volume was observed on the second and third week of the month which might be attributed to the following reasons: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* occurrence of full moon on 17 April 2022;</li> <li>* bad weather condition brought about by the Low Pressure Area affecting MIMAROPA, Bicol, Visayas &amp; Mindanao Regions and Tropical Storm Agaton affecting the rest of the country, thus, hampering the fishing operations; and</li> <li>* observance of Lenten season;</li> </ul> </li> <li>Meanwhile, more supplies of local-fresh galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrossoma</i>) were observed at the monitored retail markets throughout the month. According to vendors, supplies for local-fresh galunggong unloaded at different fish ports are abundant or "Dagsa" following the lifting of closed fishing season last February 2022. On the other hand, presence of other local galunggong variant like "balsa" (<i>Decapterus macarellus</i>), "burot" (<i>Decapterus kurroides</i>) and "galunggong babae" (<i>Decapterus russelli</i>) was also recorded this month.</li> <li>Relatively, lesser supply of imported-frozen galunggong were observed throughout the month following the abundant (Dagsa) supply of local variants among the monitored retail markets.</li> <li>Availability of alumahan (<i>Rastrelliger kanagurta</i>) was consistently observed among the monitored retail markets this month. However, there remains to be large-sized of the commodity was observed to be the majority of the supply usually sourced from Malabon Fish Port.</li> <li>The prevailing retail prices of bangus and tilapia remained stable due to the sufficient supply and steady demand at the monitored retail markets this month. However, only large size bangus were available at Trabajo and Tandang Sora markets as vendors prefer selling larger sizes of the commodity due to higher demand at the said retail markets. Meanwhile, for Tilapia, all sizes were remain available. Moreover, there is still Php20-30/kg difference between live and dead tilapia.</li> <li>Top fishery commodities in the sixteen (18) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan</li> <li>Tilapia - Batangas</li> <li>Local Galunggong - Malabon &amp; Navotas Fish Port</li> <li>Imported Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port</li> <li>Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port</li> </ol> </li> <li>Fluctuations in the prices of the top fifteen (15) and other commodities are influenced by a number of factors such as the commodity's size, quality, volume of supply, source area, as well as the weather condition and other natural phenomena. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*<i>Peneaus monodon</i> or Sugpo-small - (Php500.00/kg &amp; Php700.00/kg) - both prevailing price were noted at Farmers Market, wherein the lowest prevailing of Php500.00/kg are reportedly smaller in size, as compared to the Php700.00/kg which are noted to have larger sizes, hence the higher price.</li> <li>*<i>Scylla serrata</i> or Alimango (Php300-650/kg) -lowest prevailing price of Php300.00/kg was recorded at Malabon market and Caloocan market on Week 4, wherein supply are noted smaller sizes and dead as compared to the highest recorded prevailing price of Php650.00/kg observed in Mega-Q and Guadalupe market (week 3), which supplies are noted to be larger in sizes and sold live, hence the variation in prices.</li> <li>* <i>Thunnus albacares</i> or Tambakol - Head (Php110 - Php280/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php110.00/kg was recorded in Caloocan Market where the available supplies were directly sourced from Navotas/ Malabon Wholesale Markets resulting to a lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php280.00/kg was noted at Guadalupe Market where available supplies were sourced from nearby primary market (Farmers), which resulted to a the higher price.</li> </ul> </li> </ol>

Meanwhile, highest prevailing price of Php700.00/kg was noted on week 4 from Marikina and Guadalupe markets, wherein supply were only sourced from its nearby primary market (i.e., farmers) and or sold in a delivered price, hence offer in a higher price.</p> <p>* Atule mate or Salay-salay- (Php200.00-360.00/kg)- Lowest prevailing price of Php200.00/kg was recorded on the third week noted in Quinta, Balintawak and Muñoz markets, wherein supplies are observed smaller as compared to the highest recorded price of Php360.00/kg noted on week four of the month from secondary markets Marikina and Guadalupe which supply are observed larger and has better quality in terms of freshness both are sourced from Farmers market.</p> <p>* Cypselurus sp. or iliw (*Php100.00-200.00/kg)- Lowest recorded price of Php100.00/kg was noted in commonwealth market wherein supply are sourced directly from Navotas Fish port.
