Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of April:

- Generally, sufficient quantity of fresh marine commodities were unloaded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this month. Commodities recorded were bisugo, tambakol, tulingan, pusit, espada, dalagang bukid, betilya, and others. More specifically, ample supply of local fresh galunggong laki (*Decapterus macroma*) were observed due to the expected "dagsa" this month (April). Meanwhile, presence of other local galunggong variants were also available like balsa, babae, and burot. On the other hand, lesser volume of unloadings was observed on week 2 to week 3 which might be due to the inclement weather condition caused by Tropical Depression Agaton in most parts of the country, particularly in the Visayas, Bicol region, Quezon Province, MIMAROPA, and Mindanao; the occurrence of full moon on 17 April 2022; and the observance of Lenten Season.
- Imported-frozen galunggong remained available despite the sufficient supply of local-fresh galunggong at the Fish Port. There are still demand for imported galunggong due to its cheaper price making it easier to sell.
- Meanwhile, available unloadings of medium size alumahan (*Rastrelliger kanagurta*) was observed on week 1 and 2 sourced from Masbate Province.
- Sufficient unloading of aquaculture commodities especially for bangus and tilapia were continuously observe this month. On the other hand, large-sized commodity remained the majority of the supply noted for bangus mainly sourced from Bulacan and Pangasinan. Lastly, steady price was recorded for medium-sized tilapia, as supply of the commodity remained sufficient to cater the demand of the buying public.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local-fresh galunggong - Northern Palawan
 - Imported-frozen Galunggong - China and Vietnam
- In accordance with the General Community Quarantine (GCQ)- Alert level I, precautionary measures (e.g., wearing of face mask as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) are continuously implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex to safeguard vendors and buyers against the highly infectious COVID-19OMICRON variant.
