Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of March:

- Sufficient supplies of fresh marine commodities like gulyasan, tambakol, dalagang bukid, lapad, hipon, pusit, saliayase, tamban, burot, galunggong, balsa, turay, pompano were noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this month. Moreover, there is an increased in the supplies unloaded for local-fresh galunggong (*Decapterus* spp.). This also resulted to a decreased in the prevailing wholesale price for the said commodity. Other local-fresh galunggong variant like "babae" (*Decapterus russelli*), "burot" (*Decapterus kurroides*), and "balsa" (*Decapterus macarellus*) were also recorded at the Fish Port.
- On the other hand, supply for imported-frozen galunggong was still observed despite the sufficient supply of local galunggong at Navotas Fish Port. The prevailing wholesale price remain steady at Php120.00/kg this month.
- Both prevailing wholesale prices of bangus and tilapia remained stable due to the sufficient supply and stable demand at Navotas Fish Port. The difference in the price of Bangus may have been attributed to the source area, size, and quality unloaded. No drastic increased in the price of tilapia throughout the whole month.
- Adequate supplies for alumahan were observed this month. This might be attributed to the lifting of closed fishing season at Visayan Sea last 15 Feb 2022.
- The Closed Fishing Season for sardines at Zamboanga has been lifted last 1 March 2022. More supplies were unloaded at the Fish Port this month and are expected to increase in the coming months.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Laguna, Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local-fresh galunggong - Southern Palawan
 - Imported-frozen Galunggong - China
- Precautionary measures (e.g., wearing of face mask and face shields as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) were continuously implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex to safeguard vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
