Remarks/Market Observations	<p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of April:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Generally, the supply of fresh marine commodities remained sufficient among the monitored retail markets throughout the whole month despite the rainy weather condition. Specifically, abundant displays of medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) were observed this month chiefly sourced from Navotas Fish Port and Quezon Province. There are other local galunggong variant like "balsa" (<i>Decapterus macarellus</i>), "burot" (<i>Decapterus kurroides</i>) and "babae" (<i>Decapterus russelli</i>). Evidently, abundant supplies of galunggong "Balsa" were noted at the retail markets this month.</li> <li>As a result, only few retail markets were observed to have available supply of imported-frozen galunggong. Only Trabajo, Quinta, and Balintawak Retail Markets were recorded to have supply of imported-frozen galunggong sourced from Navotas Fish Port this month. Most of the supply recorded were still large-sized.</li> <li>Availability of medium-sized alumahan (<i>Rastrelliger kanagurta</i>) was consistently observed this month among the monitored retail markets majorly sourced from Malabon Fish Port. On the other hand, large-sized of the commodity remain the majority of the supply observed. Nevertheless, presence of other variant i.e., Hasa-hasa (<i>Rastrelliger brachysoma</i>) was also observed this month.</li> <li>No changes were recorded at the prevailing retail prices of bangus and tilapia this month. This may be attributed to the sufficient supply and stable demand at the monitored retail markets. In Trabajo and Kamuning Markets, most of the available supply of bangus were large size. Vendors prefer selling larger sizes due to higher demand. For tilapia, there is still Php20-30/kg difference between live and dead tilapia. Also, there is a Php10.00/kg difference between the price of tilapia from Pampanga compared to tilapia sourced from Batangas as consumers mostly prefer buying tilapia from Batangas due to the better quality (in terms of taste) which commands a higher price.</li> <li>Few buyers/consumers were observed on the 2nd week of the month plus some of the fish vendors did not open their stalls, which might be due to the recent 2022 National Elections.</li> <li>Top fishery commodities in the sixteen (16) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan</li> <li>Tilapia - Batangas</li> <li>Local Galunggong - Malabon &amp; Navotas Fish Port</li> <li>Imported Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port</li> <li>Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port</li> </ol> </li> <li>Fluctuations in the prices of the top fifteen (15) and other commodities are influenced by a number of factors such as the commodity's size, quality, volume of supply, source area, as well as the weather condition and other natural phenomena. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*<i>Scylla serrata</i> or Alimango - Female (Php650-1000/kg) -lowest prevailing price of Php650.00/kg was recorded at Malabon market and Munoz market on Week 1, wherein supply are noted smaller sizes and dead as compared to the highest recorded prevailing price of Php1000.00/kg observed in Kamuning and Guadalupe market (week 3), which supplies were sourced from primary markets plus supplies observed were larger and live, hence the variation in prices.</li> <li>*<i>Portunus pelagicus</i> or Alimangas - Large (Php400 - Php600/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php400.00/kg was recorded in Munoz Market where the available supplies were directly sourced from Navotas/ Malabon Wholesale Markets resulting to a lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php600.00/kg was noted at Guadalupe Market where available supplies were sourced from nearby primary market (Farmers), which resulted to a the higher price.</li> <li>*<i>Amblygaster sirm</i> or Turay- (Php220.00-360.00/kg) - both prevailing price were recorded in Guadalupe market wherein lowest prevailing price of Php220.00/kg were sourced directly from its nearby wholesale market (i.e., Malabon Fish Port) which usually offer at a lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php360.00/kg were sourced only at primary market (i.e., Farmers market), resulting to offer commodity relatively higher.</li> </ul> </li> </ol>
