Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of April:

- In general, sufficient supplies of fresh marine commodities were unloaded at Navotas Fish Port throughout the whole month. Among the fishery commodities recorded were betilya, dalagang bukid, pusit, tamban, chabeta, tulingan, matambaka, and others. Consequently, for medium-sized local-fresh galunggong (*Decapterus macrosoma*), abundant unloading of the said commodity was observed this month at prevailing wholesale price of Php120.00/kg and Php180.00/kg sourced from Visayan Sea, Northern Palawan and Quezon Province. The difference in the prices may be attributed to the source area where supplies from Quezon Province are usually higher due to its better quality (in terms of freshness). Additionally, other local-fresh variants (i.e., balsa, burot, babae) were noted at the fish port this month sourced from Northern Palawan and Batangas.
- Relatively, lesser unloading of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) observed at the Fish Port this month due to the abundant supply of its local-fresh galunggong and its variant.
- Meanwhile, there remains to be no unloading of medium-sized alumahan recorded at Navotas Fish Port this month.
- Ample supply of bangus was still noted at the fish port this month. However, large-sized of the commodity was observed to be the majority of the supply sourced from Pangasinan and Bulacan.
- For tilapia steady prevailing wholesale price of Php90.00/kg was recorded this month as the supply for the said commodity continued to be sufficient.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local-fresh galunggong - Quezon Province, Visayan Sea, Cuyo Pass, Northern & Southern Palawan
 - Imported-frozen Galunggong - China and Vietnam
- Precautionary measures (e.g., wearing of face mask and face shields as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) were continuously implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex to safeguard vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
