**Remarks/Market Observations:**

**The following observations were gathered from market personnel:**

- There is sufficient supply of fresh marine commodities observed at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale). Commodities like pusit, espada, betilya, balsa, tamban, lapad, gulyasan, tulingan were recorded at the said Fish Port. More specifically the prevailing wholesale price for medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) this week ranged from Php125.00/kg (small to medium) to Php180.00/kg (medium-large) sourced from Northern Palawan and Quezon Province, respectively. The Php60.00/kg wholesale price difference may be attributed to the varying sizes of the commodity. There are also other local galunggong variants available like balsa (*Decapterus macarellus*), babae (*Decapterus russelli*), and burot (*Decapterus kurroides*).
- Despite the sufficient supply of local-fresh galunggong, there is still available imported-frozen galunggong observed at the Navotas Fish Port. Low demand for imported-frozen galunggong was noted due to the abundant supply of local-fresh galunggong.
- No changes were observed for the wholesale prices of bangus and tilapia due to the steady demand and sufficient supply at the Fish Port. All sizes were available for tilapia and bangus.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Pangasinan, Bulacan
  - Tilapia - Batangas
  - Local galunggong- Northern Palawan, Quezon Province
  - Imported galunggong - China, Vietnam
- Market administrators continue to strictly implement precautionary safety measures in the monitored markets to ensure the consumers and vendors safety and avoid the further spread of highly infectious COVID-19 OMICRON variant in accordance with the General Community Quarantine- Alert Level 1 guidelines. Among these measures are the mandatory wearing of face masks, social distancing and regular schedule of cleaning and disinfection in the markets, and among others.
