Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- At Navotas Fish Port (wholesale), sufficient volumes of fresh marine commodities were noted this week. Among the fishery commodities observed were bisugo, lapad, betilya, balsa, pusit, espada, gulyasan, tambakol, tulingan, and others. More specifically, for medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), the recorded wholesale prices of the commodity were Php120.00/kg, Php155.00/kg, and Php170.00/kg sourced from Northern Palawan. The difference in the recorded wholesale prices may have been attributed to the varying quality (in terms of sizes and freshness) of the unloaded supplies.
- Meanwhile, two (2) brokers unloaded the medium-sized imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) on June 25, 2022 at an actual wholesale price of Php110.00/kg and Php85.00/kg for imported-frozen galunggong babae (*Decapterus russelli*), both were derived from China and Vietnam.
- Still, no medium-sized alumahan was still recorded this week at the Fish Port.
- For medium-sized bangus, stable prevailing wholesale prices of Php120.00 and 140.00/kg were recorded this week as supply of the said commodity continued to be sufficient this week sourced mainly from Bulacan and Pangasinan respectively.
- Lastly, for medium-sized tilapia, the prevailing wholesale price was still unchanged at Php90.00/kg this week, as supply remained stable to cater the demand of the buying public.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Pangasinan, Bulacan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local Galunggong- Northern Palawan
 - Alumahan- Not Available
 - Imported galunggong - China and Vietnam
- Precautionary measures (e.g., wearing of face mask and face shields as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) were continuously implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex to safeguard vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
