**Remarks/Market Observations:**

**The following observations were gathered from market personnel:**

- At Navotas Fish Port (wholesale), sufficient unloading of fresh marine commodities was reported this week. Among the fishery commodities observed were balsa, dalagang bukid, tunsoy, pusit, gulyasan, and others.
- Consequently, sufficient supplies for local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) were recorded last 2 Aug 2022 at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. However, less supply were observed on 5 Aug 2022. This resulted to a high actual wholesale price of Php160-170/kg. Other local galunggong variants like burot (*Decapterus kurroides*), balsa (*Decapterus macarellus*), babae (*Decapterus russelli*) were also recorded this week. Majority of the supplies were sourced from Zambales and Northern Palawan.
- Despite the adequate supply of local-fresh galunggong, supplies of imported-frozen galunggong (lalaki) were still available at Navotas Fish Port. The prevailing wholesale price remained at Php130.00/kg. Some of the vendors prefer selling imported galunggong due to its cheaper price making it easier to sell.
- No changes were observed at the prevailing wholesale prices of bangus and tilapia due to the sufficient supply and stable demand this week. Price may differ depending on source area, quality, and sizes.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Pangasinan, Bulacan, Laguna
  - Tilapia - Batangas
  - Local galunggong- Zambales, Northern Palawan
  - Imported galunggong - China, Vietnam
- Market administrators continue to strictly implement precautionary safety measures in the monitored markets to ensure the consumers and vendors safety and avoid the further spread of highly infectious COVID-19 OMICRON variant in accordance with the General Community Quarantine- Alert Level 1 guidelines. Among these measures are the mandatory wearing of face masks, social distancing and regular schedule of cleaning and disinfection in the markets, and among others.

*Note: Wholesale price data is as of July 31 & August 3, 2022, as price data from PFDA was not provided within the internal cut off of the covering period of this report.*
