Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of July:

- Minimal but sufficient volumes of fresh marine commodities were unloaded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this month. Among the fishery commodities recorded were lumot, pusit, hipon, lapad, tamban, tunsoy, gulyasan, turay, and others. Nevertheless, adequate supplies of medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), were recorded throughout the month (July) sourced from Visayan Sea, Northern and Southern Palawan.
- Meanwhile, unloading of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) was still observed throughout the month despite the availability of local variants at the Fish Port.
- On the other hand, no medium-sized alumahan (*Rastrelliger kanagurta*) was recorded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this month.
- As observed, majority of the supplies for bangus were large sizes obtained from Pangasinan. Further, the commodity was also noted coming from Bulacan, Laguna, Batangas, and Zambales.
- Lastly, for medium-sized tilapia, the recorded retail price of the commodity increased from Php90.00/kg last month to Php95.00/kg this month of July. The Php5.00/kg increment may have been attributed to the varying sizes of the commodity.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local-fresh galunggong - Northern Palawan
 - Imported-frozen galunggong - China and Vietnam
- In accordance with the General Community Quarantine (GCQ)- Alert level I, precautionary measures (e.g., wearing of face mask as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) are continuously implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex to safeguard vendors and buyers against the highly infectious COVID-19 OMICRON variant.
