<b>Remarks/Market Observations</b>	<p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of June:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Overall, sufficient supply of fresh marine commodities were observed among the monitored retail markets through 1st to 4th week of the month. Among the fishery commodities recorded were dalagang bukid, batalay, tulingan, bisugo, lapu-lapu, balsa, maya-maya, galunggong, tamban, tunsoy, and others. However, minimal supply of fresh marine commodities were observed during the last (5th) week of the month. This might be attributed to the hampered fishing operation caused by the bad weather condition brought by Tropical Depression "Caloy" and "Domeng". Also, the presence of Southwest monsoon affected the areas of Southern Luzon and Western Visayas.</li> <li>For local-fresh galunggong (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>), adequate display was noted for the 1st to 4th week of the month which were mainly sourced from Navotas Fish Port (Palawan). Low display of supplies were recorded during the 5th week which resulted to an increased in the prevailing price at Php200-240.00/kg. There are other local galunggong variant like "balsa" (<i>Decapterus macarellus</i>), "burot" (<i>Decapterus kurroides</i>) and "babae" (<i>Decapterus russelli</i>) observed at the retail markets.</li> <li>Only few monitored retail markets (Mega-Q &amp; Galas) have available supply of medium-sized imported-frozen galunggong sourced from Navotas Fish Port during 3rd to 5th week of the month. This may be due to the sufficient supply of its local variant. For large-sized imported galunggong, only Mega-Q Market had available supply throughout the whole month.</li> <li>Supply of medium-size alumahan (<i>Rastrelliger kanagurta</i>) remain inconsistent at the retail markets this month. Most of the supply were still large-sized sourced from Malabon Fish Port. Nonetheless, presence of other variant i.e., Hasa-hasa (<i>Rastrelliger brachysoma</i>) was also observed this month.</li> <li>The prevailing retail price of aquaculture commodities like, bangus and tilapia, remained stable due to the stable demand and sufficient supply at the monitored retail markets this month. Most of the vendors sell large size bangus due to higher demand from consumers/buyers. There is a slight increased in the retail price during the 5th week of the month which might be due to the higher transportation expenses brought by the effect of the continues increment of oil price in the country. For tilapia, there is still Php20-30/kg difference between live and dead tilapia. Also, price of tilapia sourced from Batangas are Php10.00/kg higher than the price of tilapia from Pampanga.</li> <li>Top fishery commodities in the sixteen (16) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan</li> <li>Tilapia - Batangas</li> <li>Local Galunggong - Malabon &amp; Navotas Fish Ports</li> <li>Imported Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port</li> <li>Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port</li> </ol> </li> <li>Fluctuations in the prices of the top fifteen (15) and other commodities are influenced by a number of factors such as the commodity's size, quality, volume of supply, source area, as well as the weather condition and other natural phenomena.</li> </ol> <p>*<i>Scylla serrata</i> or Alimango - Mixed (Php400-800/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php400.00/kg was recorded in Navotas Market where the available supplies were directly sourced from Navotas/ Malabon Wholesale Markets resulting to a lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php800.00/kg was noted at Guadalupe Market where available supplies were sourced from nearby primary market (Farmers), which resulted to a higher price.</p> <p>*<i>Portunus pelagicus</i> or Alimasag - Small (Php200 - Php500/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php200.00/kg was recorded in Tandang Sora, Mega-Q &amp; Caloocan Markets where the available supplies were directly sourced from Navotas/ Malabon Wholesale Markets resulting to a lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php500.00/kg was noted at Guadalupe &amp; Farmers Markets where available supplies were in good quality sourced from Lucena, which resulted to a higher price.</p> <p>*<i>Mugil cephalus</i> or Banak - (Php200.00-350.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php200.00/kg was recorded at Malabon market market on Week 2-5, wherein supply are noted smaller sizes and dead as compared to the highest recorded prevailing price of Php350.00/kg observed in Guadalupe market (week 1,2,4,5), which supplies were sourced from primary markets plus supplies observed were larger and live, hence the variation in prices.</p> <p>*<i>Spratelloides gracilis</i> or Dilis - (Php120.00-240.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php120.00/kg was recorded at Mega-Q Market on Week 5, wherein supply are noted smaller sizes and dead as compared to the highest recorded prevailing price of Php240.00/kg observed in Galas market Week 3, which supplies were sourced from primary markets plus supplies observed were larger and live, hence the variation in prices.</p>

Low influx of buyers was continuously observed among the monitored retail markets throughout the month. As a result, vendors are coping by selling lower volumes and limited varieties of fishery commodities to ensure that all supplies are sold out by the end of the day. Meanwhile, some vendors are opening on an alternate day schedule or during market days (Friday-Sunday) where there are more people in the monitored markets.</p> <p>9. Market administrators continue to strictly implement precautionary safety measures in the monitored markets to ensure the consumers and vendors safety and avoid the further spread of highly infectious COVID-19 OMICRON variant, in accordance with the General-Community Quarantine-Alert Level 1 guidelines. Among these measures are the mandatory wearing of face masks, social distancing and regular schedule of cleaning and disinfection in the markets, and among others.</p>
