Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- In general, minimal volumes of fresh marine commodities were unloaded at Navotas Fish Port this week. Among the fishery commodities recorded were tambakol, gulyasan, pusit, lumot, hipon, dalagang bukid, lapad, betilya, and others.
- No unloaded supply for medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) were recorded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. Only small-sized galunggong were reported this week at Php90.00/kg sourced from Northern Palawan. Also, majority of the supplies recorded were galunggong variant (i.e., balsa) sourced from Zambales and Batangas.
- For imported-frozen galunggong lalaki, the prevailing wholesale price remained at Php130.00/kg. This may be attributed to the stable and sufficient supply at the said fishport.
- No supply of alumahan was recorded at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week.
- The prevailing wholesale price of medium-sized bangus decreased at Php130.00/kg this week as most of the supply was sourced from Bulacan compared to previous week.
- For tilapia, the prevailing wholesale price remained relatively high at Php105-110.00/kg sourced mostly from Batangas. This may be attributed to the continuous high price of gas affecting the country.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Laguna
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local galunggong- Northern Palawan
 - Imported galunggong - China, Vietnam
- Market administrators continue to strictly implement precautionary safety measures in the monitored markets to ensure the consumers and vendors safety and avoid the further spread of highly infectious COVID-19 OMICRON variant in accordance with the General Community Quarantine- Alert Level 1 guidelines. Among these measures are the mandatory wearing of face masks, social distancing and regular schedule of cleaning and disinfection in the markets, and among others.

Note: Wholesale price data is as of September 16 & 18, 2022, as price data from PFDA was not provided within the internal cut-off of the covering period of this report.

(**) - Actual Price - price data collected did not reach the minimum requirement of three (3) samples per commodity per market. This could be due to limited volumes or no available supplies at the time of monitoring.
