<b>Remarks/Market Observations</b> <p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of July:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Generally, minimal but sufficient supplies of fresh marine commodities were observed among the monitored retail markets this month. This might have been attributed by the occurrence of the Severe Tropical Storm "Florita", Tropical Depression "Gardo" and Typhoon "Henry" noted on the fourth and fifth week of the month. Meanwhile, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) in Southwest of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur, and Southwest Monsoon were also noted in the first week of the month as well as the occurrence of full moon on 11 August 2022. Nevertheless, availability of local-fresh galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) was continuously recorded in all the monitored wet markets this month sourced mainly from Malabon Fish Port and Navotas Fish Port.</li> <li>More availability of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) was noted this month as vendors prefer to purchase the commodity due to cheaper price making it easier for them to sell.</li> <li>Adequate supply of medium-sized alumahan (<i>Rastrelliger kanagurta</i>) was recorded among the monitored retail market this month. However, majority of the supplies were still large sizes noted specifically in Farmers market sourced from Lucena (Quezon). Meanwhile, availability of other variant (i.e., Hasa-hasa) <i>Rastrelliger brachysoma</i> was also present in selected wet markets this month usually sourced from Malabon Fish Port.</li> <li>For bangus and tilapia, sufficient supplies were observed among the monitored retail markets this month. However, minimal increment in price of tilapia in the wholesale level were reported by vendors which might be attributed to the minimal supply of tilapia from Batangas caused by the fish kill in Taal Lake.</li> <li>Top fishery commodities in the sixteen (18) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan</li> <li>Tilapia - Batangas</li> <li>Local Galunggong - Malabon &amp; Navotas Fish Port</li> <li>Imported Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port</li> <li>Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port</li> </ol> </li> <li>Low influx of buyers were continuously observed this month among the monitored retail markets despite the relaxation of COVID-19 protocols in the region. As a result , lower quality (in terms of freshness) were observed in some displayed fishery commodities which are leftovers from the previous markets days. Meanwhile, vendors are coping by adjusting the volume and variety of their stocks to ensure all are sold and avoid losses.</li> <li>Fluctuations in the prices of the top fifteen (15) and other commodities are influenced by a number of factors such as the commodity's size, quality, volume of supply, source area, as well as the weather condition and other natural phenomena. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* <i>Penaes monodon</i> or Supgo (Large- Jumbo) - (Php700.00/kg - Php1100.00/kg) - Highest prevailing price of Php1100.00/kg was recorded in the third week of the month wherein majority of the supplies observed were Jumbo sizes resulting to offer relatively higher. Meanwhile, lowest prevailing price of Php700.00/kg was noted in the fifth week of the month wherein supply observed were only large size, resulting to offer in a lower price.</li> <li>*<i>Acetes</i> spp. or Alamang (Php60.00/kg &amp; 160.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php60.00/kg were recorded from Malabon Market where supplies are directly sourced from Malabon Market (primary). Highest prevailing price of Php160.00/kg was noted at Marikina Markets where available supplies were in good quality sourced from Lucena, which resulted to a higher price.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Market administrators continue to strictly implement precautionary safety measures in the monitored markets to ensure the consumers and vendors safety and avoid the further spread of highly infectious COVID-19 OMICRON variant, in accordance with the General-Community Quarantine-Alert Level 1 guidelines. Among these measures are the mandatory wearing of face masks, social distancing and regular schedule of cleaning and disinfection in the markets, and among others.</li> </ol>
