The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of August:

- 1. Overall, minimal but sufficient volumes of fresh marine commodities were unloaded at Navotas Fish Port this month. Among the fishery commodities recorded were
- dalagang bukid, lapad, labahita, betilya, gulyasan, balsa, babae, bolador, turay, pusit, lumot, and others. For local-fresh galunggong lalaki (Decapterus macrosoma), adequate supplies of medium-sized commodity was recorded throughout the month of August chiefly sourced from Palawan and Zambales.

  2. Consistent availability of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (Decapterus macrosoma) and babae (Decapterus russelli) were observed at the Fish Port this month. Availability of other imported-fishery commodities (i.e., Tulingan bilog (Auxis rochei), Hiwas (Mene maculata), Salmon (Scomber japonicus), Matambaka (Selar spp.), etc.) were also noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale).
- 3. Meanwhile, limited availability of medium-sized alumahan (Rastrelliger kanagurta) was observed this August. In fact, only in the fifth week of the month have recorded medium-sized of the commodity sourced from Bicol.
- Remarks/Market Observations:
- 4. Nonetheless, adequate supplies of bangus and tilapia were still noted at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this month. Moreover, majority of the supply of bangus remained to be large sizes sourced from Pangasinan, Bulacan, and Laguna. Meanwhile, minimal increment in price of tilapia from batangas was recorded which might be attributed by the effect of fish kill in Taal lake at Agoncillo, Batangas on 9 August 2022.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:a. Bangus Bulacan, Pangasinan
- b. Tilapia Batangas
- c. Local-fresh galunggong Northern Palawan
- d. Imported-frozen galunggong China and Vietnam

  6. Despite the relaxation of Covid-19 protocols in the region, low influx of buyers were continously observed at the fish port this month. As a result, quality of some fishery commodities sold at the wholesale markets were reportedly unsold stocks from previous market days.
