The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- 1. At Navotas Fish Port (wholesale), minimal but sufficient volumes of fresh marine commodities were reported this week. This might have been caused by the inclement weather condition caused by the Super Typhoon "Karding". Consequently, for medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (Decapterus macrosoma), only one (1) broker unloaded the commodity at the fish port on 24 September and one (1) broker on 25 September 2022 both were sourced from Northern Palawan.
- 2. İn relation, continues unloading's of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (Decapterus macrosoma) and galunggong babae (Decapterus russelli) were recorded this week sourced from China and Vietnam.
- 3. Meanwhile, no medium-sized alumahan was still recorded this week at the Fish Port.
- 4. For aquaculture commodities (i.e., bangus and tilapia), adequate unloadings were still noted this week at the Fish Port. However, minimal supply of bangus from Pangasinan was recorded this week.

Remarks/Market Observations:

- $6. Top \ fishery \ commodities \ in \ the \ monitored \ markets \ are \ sourced \ mainly \ from \ the \ following \ are as:$
- a. Bangus Laguna, Bulacan
- b. Tilapia Batangas
- c. Local Galunggong- Northern Palawan
- d. Alumahan- Not Available
- e. Imported galunggong China and Vietnam
- 7. Limited number of buyers was still noted this week at the Fish Port. Alongside, lower quality in terms of freshness was observed in some displayed fishery commodities this week as majority of the supplies are leftover from the previous market days.

Note: Wholesale price data is as of Sepetember 24 & 25, 2022, as price data from PFDA was not provided within the internal cut off time for the covering period of this report.
