Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- At Navotas Fish Port (wholesale), sufficient unloading of fresh marine commodities were noted this week. Among the supplies available were galunggong variant (i.e., balsa), tambakol, gulyasan, betilya, matambaka, dalagang bukid, tunsoy, lapad, pusit, hipon, and others.
- However, for medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), only one (1) broker were recorded unloading the commodity at the fish port this week. The recorded actual wholesale price was at Php113.00/kg sourced from Northern Palawan.
- Imported-frozen galunggong continuous to be available at the Navotas Fish Port this week. This resulted to a stable prevailing wholesale price at Php130-132/kg.
- No supply of alumahan was recorded at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week.
- The prevailing wholesale price of medium-sized bangus remained at Php130.00/kg this week due to the stable demand and sufficient supply at the market.
- For tilapia, the prevailing wholesale price remained relatively high at Php100-110.00/kg sourced mostly from Batangas. This may be attributed to the continuous high price of gas affecting the country.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local galunggong- Northern Palawan
 - Imported galunggong - China, Vietnam
- Market administrators continue to strictly implement precautionary safety measures in the monitored markets to ensure the consumers and vendors safety and avoid the further spread of highly infectious COVID-19 OMICRON variant in accordance with the General Community Quarantine- Alert Level 1 guidelines. Among these measures are the mandatory wearing of face masks, social distancing and regular schedule of cleaning and disinfection in the markets, and among others.

Note: Wholesale price data is as of October 8 & 11, 2022, as price data from PFDA was not provided within the internal cut off of the covering period of this report.
