**Remarks/Market Observations:**

**The following observations were gathered from market personnel:**

- Overall, minimal volume of fresh marine commodities were unloaded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. More specifically, limited unloading of local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), was recorded sourced from Palawan. Nevertheless, availability of pusit, alimasag, dalagang bukid, tulingan, tunsoy, lapad, sapsap, and others were reported at wholesale market.
- Presence of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) and galunggong babae (*Decapterus russelli*) were still recorded this week sourced from China and Vietnam.
- Meanwhile, supply of medium-sized alumahan (*Rastrelliger kanagurta*) remain unavailable this week at Navotas Fish Port wholesale market.
- On the other hand, adequate supplies of bangus and tilapia were still observed this week at Navotas Fish Port sourced mainly from Bulacan, Pangasinan, and Batangas.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Laguna, Bulacan
  - Tilapia - Batangas
  - Local Galunggong- Palawan
  - Alumahan- Not Available
  - Imported galunggong - China and Vietnam
- Low influx of buyers was continuously observed at Navotas wholesale market this week. As a result, lower quality (in terms of freshness) was observed on some displayed fishery commodities which are noted to be the leftover from the previous market days. In connection, some vendors tend to offer their product in a lower or bargain price in order to gain back their capital.

*Note: Wholesale price data is as of October 12 & 17, 2022, as price data from PFDA was not provided within the internal cut off time for the covering period of this report.*
