Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Minimal supplies of fresh marine commodities were available in the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week due to the inclement weather condition brought by Severe Tropical Storm "Paeng". Among the commodities observed were pusit, alakaak, tunsoy, lapad, tambakol, gulyasan, dalagang bukid, tulingan, and others.
- Limited volume of supply for medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) was observed at Navotas Fish Port this week. This may be attributed to the effects of STS "Paeng" plus the upcoming Closed Fishing Season (CFS) at Northeastern Palawan on 1 Nov. The recorded actual wholesale price was at Php113.00 & Php180.00/kg sourced from Northern Palawan.
- For imported-frozen galunggong, higher volume of supply was available at the Navotas Fish Port due to the higher demand from the consumer this week caused by the limited supply of fresh marine commodities. This resulted to a prevailing wholesale price at Php130.00/kg.
- No supply of alumahan was recorded at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week.
- There is a decreased in the wholesale price of bangus due to the smaller sizes available as supplies recorded were small-medium size. The actual wholesale price of bangus is at Php110.00/kg this week.
- The prevailing wholesale price for tilapia remained relatively high at Php100.00/kg sourced mostly from Batangas this week. This may be attributed to the continuous high price of gas affecting the country.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local galunggong- Northern Palawan
 - Imported galunggong - China, Vietnam
- Market administrators continue to strictly implement precautionary safety measures in the monitored markets to ensure the consumers and vendors safety and avoid the further spread of highly infectious COVID-19 OMICRON variant in accordance with the General Community Quarantine- Alert Level 1 guidelines. Among these measures are the mandatory wearing of face masks, social distancing and regular schedule of cleaning and disinfection in the markets, and among others.

Note: Wholesale price data is as of October 22 & 24, 2022, as price data from PFDA was not provided within the internal cut off of the covering period of this report.
