Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Limited unloading of fresh marine commodities were noted at Navotas Fish Port Complex (wholesale) this week. This may due to the onslaught of Severe Tropical Storm Paeng and the start of Closed Fishing Season (CFS) for galunggong species (*Decapterus spp.*) in Northern Palawan. Consequently, according to PFDA database, only one (1) broker unloaded medium-sized galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) at the fish port this week.
- For imported-frozen galunggong, higher volume of supply was available at the Navotas Fish Port this week. Also, higher demand from the consumers were observed which may be caused by the limited supply of fresh marine commodities especially local-fresh galunggong due to the CFS in Northern Palawan. The prevailing wholesale price increased at Php130-137.00/kg this week.
- Still, no supply of alumahan was recorded at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week.
- The prevailing wholesale price of bangus remained at Php110.00/kg this week due to the sufficient and stable supply at the Navotas Fish Port. Moreover, the unloaded supplies this week consist of small to medium-sized.
- No changes were observed for the prevailing wholesale price of tilapia at Php100-105.00/kg this week due to the sufficient supply at Navotas Fish Port. The relatively high wholesale price may attributed to the continuous high price of gas affecting the country.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local galunggong- Northern Palawan
 - Imported galunggong - China, Vietnam
- Market administrators continue to strictly implement precautionary safety measures in the monitored markets to ensure the consumers and vendors safety and avoid the further spread of highly infectious COVID-19 OMICRON variant in accordance with the General Community Quarantine- Alert Level 1 guidelines. Among these measures are the mandatory wearing of face masks, social distancing and regular schedule of cleaning and disinfection in the markets, and among others.

Note: Wholesale price data is as of October 24 and November 1 2022, as price data from PFDA was not provided within the internal cut off of the covering period of this report.
