Remarks/Market Observations	<p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of October:</p> <p>1. Overall, minimal display of fresh marine commodities were observed among the monitored retail markets this month. This may be attributed to the hampered fishing operations caused by the unfavorable weather condition in the country brought by the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ), and presence of Tropical Depression "Neneng" (2nd week), Tropical Depression "Obet" (3rd week), and Severe Tropical Storm "PAENG" (4th week) of the month. Relatively, limited availability of local fresh galunggong lalaki was recorded this month sourced mainly from Malabon and Navotas Fish Port.</p> <p>2. In connection, more availability of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) was recorded this month as vendors prefer to purchased the commodity due its affordable price enabling them to sell it easily.</p> <p>3. Similarly, limited display of medium-sized alumahan, (<i>Rastrelliger kanagurta</i>) was recorded among the monitored retail markets this month. As large-sized commodity was apparently the majority of supply in the markets. Moreover, availability of other variant of the commodity (i.e., Hasa-hasa) <i>Rastrelliger brachysoma</i> was recorded chiefly sourced from Malabon Fish Port.</p> <p>4. Meanwhile, sufficient display of aquaculture commodities (i.e., bangus and tilapia) were recorded throughout the month. As a result, prices of both commodities remained stable. Nonetheless, high wholesale prices of the said commodities were reported by vendors especially supply of bangus coming from Dagupan and the supply of tilapia from Batangas.</p> <p>5. Top fishery commodities in the sixteen (18) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga Local Galunggong - Malabon & Navotas Fish Port Imported Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port <p>6. Still, low influx of buyers were apparently observed among the monitored retail markets throughout the month. In connection, vendors were noted selling lower volume and variety of fishery commodities to ensure all displays will be sold by the end of the day to avoid losses. Further, as observed, some of the displayed fishery commodities were remaining stocks from previous market days.</p> <p>7. Fluctuations in the prices of the top fifteen (15) and other commodities are influenced by a number of factors such as the commodity's size, quality, volume of supply, source area, as well as the weather condition and other natural phenomena.</p> <p>* <i>Penaeus monodon</i> or Sugpo (Small) - (Php320.00/kg - Php680.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php320.00/kg noted in the third week of the month were recorded from Caloocan Market wherein supplies recorded were small-sized and not in good quality (supplies from previous days). Highest prevailing price of Php680.00/kg was noted at Farmers Market where supplies recorded were in good quality sourced from Lucena, Quezon.</p> <p>* <i>Penaeus monodon</i> or Sugpo (Large-Jumbo) - (Php650.00/kg & Php750.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php 650.00/kg were recorded in the first and second week of the month wherein supplies recorded were both noted in primary markets which are sourcing directly from their nearby wholesale markets enabling them to offer in a cheaper price. Meanwhile, highest recorded price of Php 750.00/kg were noted in the third and fourth week of the month wherein supply recorded were from Farmers market which display of the commodity was premium quality (in terms of freshness), hence offer in higher price.</p> <p>* <i>Decapterus macrosoma</i> or Galunggong lalaki (small) - (Php140.00/kg - Php240.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php140.00/kg were recorded in primary markets (i.e., Malabon Central and Caloocan) wherein both are sourced directly from its nearby wholesale markets. Meanwhile, supply noted in the fourth week of the month was observed in secondary market (i.e., Guadalupe market) wherein supply are sourced only from its nearby primary market (i.e., Farmers market), hence offer in a higher price.</p> <p>* <i>Acanthurus</i> spp. or Labahita (Php 240/kg - 350.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php240.00/kg were recorded in the third week of the month wherein supplies observed are smaller in size as compared to the supplies observed in the first week of the month which noted to have larger size, hence offer in a higher price.</p> <p>* <i>Caesio caeruleaurea</i> or Labahita (Php 200.00/kg - 300.00/kg) - Meanwhile, lowest prevailing price of Php 200.00/kg noted in the third week of the month was observed lower in quality in terms of freshness as compared to the supply observed in the fourth week (Php300.00/kg) which have noted to have better in quality, resulting to sell in a premium price.</p> <p>* <i>Caranx</i> spp. or Talakitok (Php 300.00/kg - 500.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php300.00/kg were noted in the fourth week of the month wherein display recorded were smaller in size as compared the supply noted in the second week of the month which have recorded the highest prevailing price of Php 500.00/kg.</p> <p>* <i>Jagora asperata</i> or Suso pilipit (Php 100.00/kg - 200.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php100.00/kg were recorded at Malabon Market which usually offers a lower price as it directly source their supplies to nearby wholesale markets (i.e., Malabon Fish port). Highest prevailing price of Php200.00/kg were noted from secondary Market, Marikina market which sources their supplies from nearby primary markets (i.e., Farmers), resulting to relatively higher prices.</p> <p>* <i>Lates calcalifer</i> or Apahap- (Php300.00/kg - 450.00/kg) - both prevailing prices were recorded in Guadalupe market wherein, the lowest recorded price of Php300.00/kg were sourced directly from Malabon Fish Port. On the other hand, the highest recorded price of Php450.00/kg was only sourced from secondary market (i.e., Farmers), hence sell in a higher price.</p> <p>* <i>Siganus guttatus</i> or Samaral- (Php300.00/kg - 400.00/kg) - Both prevailing prices were recorded in the first week of the month wherein the lowest recorded price of Php300.00/kg was noted smaller in size as compared to the highest recorded price of Php400.00/kg which are noted to be larger, hence the variation in price.</p> <p>* <i>Trichurus japonicus</i> or Espada- (Php250.00/kg - 360.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php250.00/kg were noted in the fourth week of the month wherein display recorded were smaller in size as compared the supply noted in the second week of the month which have recorded the highest prevailing price of Php 360.00/kg.</p> <p>* <i>Tylosorus</i> spp. or Batalay- (Php80.00/kg - 280.00/kg) - Meanwhile, lowest prevailing price of Php 80.00/kg noted in the first week of the month was observed lower in quality in terms of freshness as compared to the supply observed in the third week (Php300.00/kg) which have noted to have better in quality, resulting to sell in a premium price.</p>
