Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of October:

- Minimal unloading of fresh marine commodities were noted at Navotas Fish Port this month. Among the supplies available were galunggong variant (i.e., balsa), tambakol, gulyasan, betilya, matambaka, dalagang bukid, tunsoy, lapad, pusit, hipon, and others. More specifically, limited unloading of local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrostoma*), was recorded sourced from Palawan.
- Meanwhile, consistent availability of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrostoma*) and babae (*Decapeterus russelli*) were observed at the Fish Port this month. Availability of other imported-fishery commodities (i.e., Tulingan bilog (*Auxis rochei*), Hiwas (*Mene maculata*), Salmon (*Scomber japonicus*), Matambaka (*Selar spp.*), etc.) were also noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale).
- Meanwhile, no medium-sized alumahan (*Rastrelliger kanagurta*) was recorded this October.
- Nevertheless, adequate supplies of bangus and tilapia were noted at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this month. Moreover, majority of the supply of bangus remained to be large-sized sourced from Pangasinan and Bulacan.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
  - Tilapia - Batangas
  - Local-fresh galunggong - Northern Palawan
  - Imported-frozen galunggong - China and Vietnam
- In general, low influx of buyers were continuously observed at the fish port this month. As a result, quality of some fishery commodities sold at the wholesale markets were reportedly unsold stocks from previous market days.

(\*\*) - Actual Wholesale - price data collected did not reach the minimum requirement of three (3) samples per commodity per market. This could be due to limited volumes or no available supplies at the time of monitoring
