- 1. According to PFDA database, there were sufficient unloadings of fresh marine commodities in Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) $this week. Despite the implementation of Closed Fishing Season (CFS) for local galunggong at Northern Palawan last November 1 and for sardines, herrings, mackarels at Visayan Sea last November 15, availability of the mentioned commodities were still observed at Navotas Fish Port this week. The prevailing wholesale price of local galunggong was at Php200.00/kg sourced from Zambales, Batangas, Balabac Strait (Palawan), and Mindoro and for alumahan actual wholesale price of Php220.00/kg was recorded chiefly derived from Masbate.

3. More supplies of imported-frozen galunggong were reported at Navotas Fish Port this week as high demand for the commodity continuous to be observed. According to fish vendors, buyers prefer selling imported-frozen galunggong as the wholesale price of local galunggong remained high this week. The prevailing wholesale price remained at Php130.00/kg. 5. - 6. The recorded prevailing wholesale price of tilapia was at Php90.00/kg this week due to the continuous supply at Navotas Fish Port.
- 7. Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
- a. Bangus Pangasinan
- b. Tilapia Batangas
- c. Local galunggong- Zambales, Batangas, Balabac Strait, Palawan, Mindoro
- d. Alumahan- Masbate
- e. Imported galunggong China, Vietnam

8. Market administrators continue to strictly implement precautionary safety measures in the monitored markets to ensure the consumers and vendors safety and avoid the further spread of highly infectious COVID-19 OMICRON variant in accordance with the General Community Quarantine- Alert Level 1 guidelines. Among these measures are the mandatory wearing of face masks, social distancing and regular schedule of cleaning and disinfection in the markets, and among others.

Note: Wholesale price data is as of November 27 & 29 2022, as price data from PFDA was not provided within the internal cut off of the covering period of this report.
