Remarks/Market Observations	<p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of November:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Generally, sufficient display of fresh marine commodities were recorded among the monitored retail markets this month. However, limited availability of the said commodities were noted on the first and second week of the month which might be attributed to the hampered fishing operations brought by the onslaught of Severe Tropical Storm "Paeng". Consequently, limited availability of local fresh galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) was recorded throughout the month alongside the implementation of Closed Fishing Season (CFS) of galunggong species in Northern Palawan. Adequate supplies of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) were recorded this month chiefly sourced from Navotas Fish Port. Presence of other imported-frozen commodities (i.e., pomfret, chub mackerel, Atlantic salmon, moonfish, and Indian scad) were also noted in the monitored retail markets this month. For alumahan, limited display of medium-sized commodity was observed this month sourced mainly from Malabon Fish Port. Meanwhile, display of other variant (i.e., Hasa-hasa) was also noted. Sufficient availability of aquaculture commodities (i.e., bangus and tilapia) were recorded throughout this month. On the other hand, minimal supplies of medium-sized bangus were noted which could possibly be due to the limited unloading's of the commodity wherein fish farmer might limit their harvest to attain maximum maturity of their stocks which will have better demand and pricing in the upcoming holiday season. Top fishery commodities in the sixteen (16) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga Local Galunggong - Malabon Fish Port Imported Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port Meanwhile, there continues to have low influx of buyers were observed among the monitored retail markets throughout the month. In connection, vendors were noted selling lower volume and variety of fishery commodities to ensure all displays will be sold by the end of the day to avoid losses. Further, as observed, some of the displayed fishery commodities were remaining stocks from previous market days. Fluctuations in the prices of the top fifteen (15) and other commodities are influenced by a number of factors such as the commodity's size, quality, volume of supply, source area, as well as the weather condition and other natural phenomena. <i>Penaeus monodon</i> or Sugo (Mixed) - (Php750.00, 800.00, 880.00/kg) - both prevailing price were noted in the third week of the month wherein lowest recorded price of Php750.00/kg was observed low in quality (supplies from previous days). Meanwhile, the highest prevailing price of Php880.00/kg was noted to have better quality (in terms of freshness). <i>Scylla serrata</i> or Alimango (mixed) (Php220.00-950.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php220.00/kg was noted in second week of the month wherein the supply recorded was noted smaller in size. Meanwhile, supply observed in fourth week was reportedly larger in size hence offer relatively higher. <i>Thunnus albacares</i> or Yellowfin - (Php120.00/kg & 240.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php120.00/kg were recorded from Marikina Market where supplies recorded were not in good quality (supplies from previous days). Highest prevailing price of Php240.00/kg was noted at Pasig Market where supplies recorded were in good quality sourced from Lucena, Quezon. <i>Pterocasio chrysozona</i> or Dalagang Bukid bilog (Php280.00-400.00/kg) - lowest recorded price of Php280.00/kg was observed smaller as compared to the highest recorded price of Php400.00/kg which have larger size, hence offer in premium price. <i>Stolephorus comersonii</i> or Dilis (100.00-280.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php100.00/kg were recorded from third week of the month wherein majority of the supplies recorded were not in good quality (supplies from previous days). Meanwhile, highest prevailing price of Php280.00/kg was noted at second week of the month where supplies recorded were in good quality and relatively larger in size.
