**Fisheries General Memorandum Order No. 006**  
Series of 2021

**Subject: Guidelines on the submission of Project Proposals for funding of Aquatic Wildlife Management Fund (AWMF) pursuant to FAO 233 series of 2010**

To strengthen and harmonize the format of project proposals to be funded by the Aquatic Wildlife Management Fund (AWMF), the following guidelines and requirements are hereby implemented:

1. The Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) Central and Regional Offices, scientific authorities and Philippine Aquatic Red-List Committee (PARLC) are qualified to submit Project Proposals for funding of AWMF;
2. Proposals shall focus on the conservation, rehabilitation, restoration and protection of aquatic wildlife and resources, research and/or population assessment, capacity building trainings, enhancement of capabilities, and aquatic wildlife law enforcement activities;
3. Proposals with capital outlay maybe accepted, subject to the availability of funds;
4. Project proposals which include hiring of project-based personnel maybe allowed, subject to the availability of funds;
5. Content of the project proposals shall be in accordance with the memorandum on 'Format of Project Proposals' dated April 20, 2020 herein referred to as Annex A; and
6. Project proposals from regional offices shall seek the approval of the Regional Aquatic Wildlife Management Committee (RAWMC) prior to submission to the National Aquatic Wildlife Management Committee (NAWMC) Secretariat.
