Remarks/Market Observations	<p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of December:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Generally, limited display of fresh marine commodities, especially for local galunggong, sardines, herrings and mackerels, were recorded among the monitored retail markets this month. This may be attributed to the following: a.) Implementation of Closed Fishing Season(CFS) on local galunggong (<i>Decapterus</i> spp.) at Northern Palawan last 1 November and on sardines, herrings & mackerel at Visayan Sea last 15 November. b.) Bad weather condition brought by the occurrence of Tropical Storm "Rosal" affecting Bicol region, Eastern Visayas, Central Visayas, Caraga, and Davao region last 10-12 Dec. c.) Hampered fishing operations in the country brought about by the occurrence of Low Pressure Area (LPA) on the last week of the month. Due to the limited supply of local-fresh galunggong, most of the supply available at the monitored retail markets were imported-frozen galunggong as vendors look for a substitute commodity for local galunggong. There are also other imported-frozen commodities observed like pomfret, chub mackerel, Atlantic salmon, moonfish, Indian scad, and shortfin scad this month. The prevailing retail prices of aquaculture commodities (i.e., bangus and tilapia) increased at Php120-140.00/kg and Php180.00/kg this month. The increase in the prices may be attributed to the increase in demand brought by the upcoming Christmas holiday. Most of the supplies observed among the monitored retail markets were large-sized as fish farmers delay their harvest time last month to attain the maximum maturity of their stocks which will have better demand and pricing during this Christmas holiday season. Top fishery commodities in the seventeen (17) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga Local Galunggong - Malabon Fish Port Imported Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port There is a high influx of buyers observed at the monitored retail markets especially on the 3rd and 4th week of the month due to the Christmas Holiday. This resulted to a higher prevailing retail prices for the fishery commodities this month. Also, the minimal supply of fresh marine commodities contributed to the increase in prices. Fluctuations in the prices of the top fifteen (15) and other commodities are influenced by a number of factors such as the commodity's size, quality, volume of supply, source area, as well as the weather condition and other natural phenomena. <p>* <i>Portunus pelagicus</i> or Alimasag (Small-Medium) - (Php140-450.00/kg) - both prevailing price were noted in the third week of the month wherein lowest recorded price of Php140.00/kg was observed at Caloocan Market where supplies were low in quality (supplies from previous days). Meanwhile, the highest prevailing price of Php450.00/kg was noted at Marikina Market where supplies recorded have better quality (in terms of freshness).</p> <p>* <i>Jagora asperata</i> or Suso pilipit (Php100.00-200.00/kg)- the highest and lowest prevailing price was noted from 1st to 4th week of the month wherein the lowest price at Php100.00/kg was noted at Malabon Market where price tend to be cheaper as supplies were mainly sourced from Malabon Fish Port. smaller in size. The highest price at Php200.00/kg was recorded at Marikina Market where supplies observed were sourced from a secondary market resulting to a higher price.</p> <p>* <i>Mene maculata</i> or Chabeta - (Php200.00/kg & 300.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php200.00/kg were noted in 1st and 2nd week and was recorded from Quinta, Commonwealth, and Munoz Market where supplies recorded were imported-frozen which results to lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php300.00/kg was noted from 3rd and 4th week and were noted at Marikina Market where supplies recorded were sourced from Lucena, Quezon.</p> <p>* <i>Salmo salar</i> or Salmon - Meat (Php800.00-900.00/kg)- lowest prevailing price of Php800.00/kg were recorded from 1st and 2nd week of the month wherein lesser demand was recorded resulting to less price. Meanwhile, highest prevailing price of Php900.00/kg was noted at 3rd and 4th week of the month where higher demand was observed due to the christmas holiday.</p> <p>* <i>Upeneus</i> spp. or Saramulyete (180.00-300.00/kg)- lowest and highest prevailing price were recorded from 1st week of the month at Commonwealth Market wherein the the lowest price is at Php180.00/kg where supplies recorded was not in good quality. The highest prevailing price of Php300.00/kg were in good quality and relatively larger in size.</p>
