Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of December:

- At Navotas Fish Port (wholesale), minimal unloading of fresh marine commodities, especially for local galunggong, sardines, herrings, and mackerels, were recorded due to the implementation of Closed Fishing Season (CFS) for local galunggong at Northern Palawan (*Decapterus macrosoma*) last November 1 and for sardines, herrings, mackerels at Visayan Sea last November 15. Also, the rainy weather condition brought by Tropical Storm "Rosal" on 2nd week and Low Pressure Area (LPA) on the 3rd to 4th week of the month contributed to the limited unloaded of fishery commodities this month.
- For imported-frozen galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) and babae (*Decapterus russelli*), prevailing wholesale prices were observed to increase due to the nearing of Christmas Holiday Season. Nonetheless, the supply were noted to be sufficient to cater the demand of the consuming public this month. There are also other imported-fishery commodities available (i.e., Pampano (*Trachinotus* sp.), Tulingan bilog (*Auxis rochei*), Hiwas (*Mene maculata*), Salmon (*Scomber japonicus*), etc.) noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale).
- There is a slight increase in the prevailing wholesale price of bangus this month due to the increase in demand brought by the Christmas Holiday Season.
- For tilapia, no changes were observed in the prevailing wholesale price due to the stable and sufficient supply at the fish port.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local-fresh galunggong - Northern Palawan
 - Imported-frozen galunggong - China and Vietnam
- Due to the effects on demand on Christmas Holiday Season, higher number of buyers were observed at the fish port this month.

(*) - Actual Wholesale - price data collected did not reach the minimum requirement of three (3) samples per commodity per market. This could be due to limited volumes or no available supplies at the time of monitoring
