Remarks/Market Observations:		Nonetheless, availability of other local galunggong variants (i.e., burot and galunggong babae) were recorded in the fish port this week. 2. Meanwhile, for medium-sized imported-frozen galunggong lalaki the prevailing wholesale price was stable at Php140.00/kg chiefly sourced from Vietnam. 3. Available supply of medium-sized alumahan (<i>Rastrelliger kanagurta</i>) was also observed this week with a recorded actual wholesale price of Php230.00/kg and Php235.00/kg sourced from Masbate and Quezon Province. 4. Nonetheless, adequate supplies of bangus and tilapia were still noted at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. However, no supplies of medium-sized bangus from Pangasinan were still recorded as large-sized bangus were unloaded at the fish port this week. Meanwhile, supplies of medium to large-sized bangus from Bulacan continued to be present in the fish port with steady prevailing wholesale price of Php140.00/kg. 5. Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: a. Bangus -Bulacan b. Tilapia - Batangas c. Local Galunggong - Plawan d. Alumahan- Quezon Province, Masbate e. Inported galunggong - Vietnam 6. Low influx of buyers remains to be evident this week at the Fish Port. As a result, lower quality of some displayed fishery commodities were observed this week. <i>Note: Wholesale price data is as of February 4 & 7, 2023, as price data from PFDA was not provided within the internal cut off of the covering period</i> <i>of this report.</i>
