

ESTABLISHMENT OF LEGISLATED HATCHERIES

IN LINGIG, SURIGAO DEL SUR AND JABONGA, AGUSAN DEL SUR

TERMS OF REFERENCE

BACKGROUND

High-quality seed, of known breeding history, is increasingly sought in aquaculture because, with appropriate husbandry, its performance is more predictable than that from seed of unknown provenance.

Provision of adequate quantities of good quality wild or domesticated, genetically improved seed for aquaculture is highly complex. It depends upon a wide range of environmental, biological, and socioeconomic factors that are often interactive. For seed that is collected from the wild or raised from wild caught broodstock, available quantities depend mainly upon the status of the capture fisheries from which the seed or broodstock are taken. Many of these fisheries are in decline through overexploitation and environmental degradation. The live reef food fish trade for marine carnivorous finfish (groupers and snappers) is a good example (ADB, 2003).

The aquaculture subsector in the Philippines has not yet realized its full potential in terms of contribution to national growth and development. One of the reasons is the issue of resource depletion. The reliance of wild seed stock, limited species varieties and high cost of fry has resulted in depletion of wild/natural stock over time. The depletion problem, in turn, is associated with the lack of hatchery technology as well as limited funds/investment for hatchery and broodstock development.

The House of Representatives undertakes measures to provide concrete solutions to address these problems through passing a House Bill and enactment of legislation and in addressing food security, promoting sustainable development of fisheries resources and reducing poverty incidence among the fisherfolk.

Republic Act 10787 and 10813 mandates BFAR to establish under its supervision a multispecies hatchery in Lingig, Surigao del Sur, and Jabonga, Agusan del Norte. In order to operate the hatchery, microscopes and laboratory equipment that measure water quality parameters such as salinity, pH levels and temperature are required. The equipment will allow the technicians to ensure that the fry would thrive in clean and non-toxic waters. This would also make sure that the production estimates presented in the feasibility study will be met, improving fish and seafood sufficiency. Hence this project is being proposed to operationalize the provisions of the law.

II. OBJECTIVES

The goal of this project is to strengthen the hatchery industry to address critical farming issues, such as limited species variety, high fry cost and erratic supply.

Specific:

To construct the multi-species hatcheries in the following sites:

- Lingig, Surigao del Sur
- Jabonga, Agusan del Norte,

III. QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- The bidders must have completed a similar contract/project Equivalent to fifty percent (50%) of the ABC within five (5) years from the date of the Bid Opening.

1. The winning bidder shall certify that he/she, at his/her own expense, inspected and examined the proposed project site and its surroundings related to the delivery of the

- work and has obtained all the pieces of information that are considered necessary for the delivery of the equipment.
- They will be held accountable for accidents that might occur during the delivery of equipment.
- They will be responsible for the supply, delivery, installation, testing, and commissioning of equipment.
- 4. They should provide basic training on how to operate the equipment to the end-user.
- 5. They should start delivering upon receiving notice to proceed within 180 calendar days.
- The bidder should provide a warranty certificate with the inclusion of parts and services for a period of One (1) year.
- 7. Coordinate with the BFAR-IFAD regarding the delivery of equipment.

VI. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF BFAR-IFAD

- Notify the supplier in writing, in a timely manner, of the identity of any representatives
 retained for these purposes. All reasonable facilities and assistance for the inspection
 and testing, including access to drawings, shall be provided by the supplier to the
 authorized inspector at no charge to the Procuring Entity.
- 2. Coordinate with the winning bidder regarding the delivery of Laboratory Equipment.
- 3. Conduct monitoring and evaluation in the delivery of Laboratory Equipment.
- 4. Provide technical assistance (basic orientation on how to operate the equipment)
- Issue a certificate of inspection and acceptance upon the determination by the End User that the delivered equipment is already completed.
