Remarks/Market Observations:		<p>The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of January:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Limited unloading of fresh marine commodities were observed at the Navotas Fish Port this month. Among the commodities observed were dalagang bukid, kabase, lapad, gulyasan, tambakol, pusit, dilis, bisugo, biluan, matambaka, and others. Meanwhile, supplies of medium-sized galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) were stable at Php200.00/kg sourced from Mindoro, Southern Palawan, Batangas, and Zambales. On the other hand, sufficient unloading of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki were observed throughout the month as the demand for the commodity continued to be high due to minimal supplies of its local variant. On the other hand, availability of other imported commodities (i.e., Chub mackerel, and squid) were also observed this month. Relatively, minimal availability of medium-size alumahan (<i>Rastrelliger kanagurta</i>) was observed this month. In fact, only on the fourth week of the month the commodity was recorded with actual wholesale price of Php200.00/kg sourced from Quezon Province. For aquaculture commodities (i.e., bangus and tilapia), sufficient supplies were still noted this month at the fish port. However, availability of large-sized bangus remained the majority of the supplies due to better demand in the market. Meanwhile, availability of tilapia were still noted in the fish port mostly sourced from Batangas. Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan Tilapia - Batangas Local-fresh galunggong - Batangas, Zambales Imported-frozen galunggong - Vietnam High wholesale prices of marine fishery commodities were still recorded this month at the fish port as the supplies were remain affected by cold weather condition in the country brought by the Low Pressure Area (LPA) and Northeast monsoon "Hanging amihan".
