The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- 1. Minimal but sufficient availability of fresh marine commodities were noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. Among the commodities recorded were sapsap, tambakol, gulyasan, dalagang bukid, silinyase, alakaak, dilis, pusit, alimasag, kabase, and others. - 2. Meanwhile, for medium-sized imported-frozen galunggong lalaki the prevailing wholesale price was stable at Php140.00/kg chiefly sourced from Vietnam.
- 3. Supply of medium-sized alumahan (Rastrelliger kanagurta) remained unavailable this week at Navotas Fish Port.
- 4. Adequate supplies of bangus and tilapia were still noted at the Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week with a recorded prevailing price of Php140.00/kg (Bulacan) and Php160.00/kg (Pangasinan). However, majority of the unloaded supplies of bangus from Pangasinan were still large-sized. 5. Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
- Remarks/Market Observations: a. Bangus -Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - b. Tilapia Batangas
 - c. Local Galunggong- Zambales, Palawan
 - d. Alumahan- Not available
 - e. Imported galunggong Vietnam
 - 6. High prices of marine fishery commodities were still observed throughout the week at Navotas Fish Port wholesale. This might be attributed due to the ampered fishing operations brought by the effect of Low Pressure Area (LPA) in the country.

Note: *Wholesale price data is as of February 17, 2023, as price data from PFDA was not provided within the internal cut off of the coverina period of this report.
