The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- 1. At Navotas Fish Port (wholesale), minimal but sufficient unloading of fresh marine commodities were noted this week. Fresh marine commodities recorded includes bariles, salinyase, lapad, bakoko, tulingan, dalagang bukid, tamban, batalay, and others. More specifically, for medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (Decapterus macrosoma), two (2) brokers unloaded the commodity with actual wholesale prices of Php180.00/kg and Php200.00/kg sourced from Northern Palawan and Zambales, respectively, on 26 February 2023. Price difference may be attributed to the varying source areas and quality (in terms of sizes) of commodity in the fish port. Nonetheless, other variants of local-fresh galunggong lalaki such as "balsa" (Decapterus macarellus) and "burot" (Decapterus kurroides) were noted.
- 2. On the other hand, adequate unloading of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki was still recorded at Navotas Fish Port this week sourced from Vietnam. Supply of imported-galunggong babae was also observed.
- Remarks/Market Observations:
- 3. Meanwhile, no supply of medium-sized alumahan (Rastrelliger kanagurta) was still recorded in Navotas Fish Port this week.
- 4. Sufficient supplies of aquaculture commodities (i.e., bangus and tilapia) were still observed this week. However, supplies of large-sized bangus remained the majority of the displayed bangus at the fish port.

  5. Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
- a. Bangus -Bulacan
- b. Tilapia Batangas
- c. Local Galunggong- Zambales, Northern Palawan d. Alumahan- Not available
- e. Imported galunggong Vietnam

Note: Wholesale price data is as of February 26, 2023, as price data from PFDA was not provided within the internal cut off of the covering period of this report.
