Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- As the Northeast Monsoon and Low-Pressure Area (LPA) continuous to brought effect in Visayas and Mindanao, minimal but sufficient supplies of fresh marine commodities were recorded in Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. Among the commodities noted were pusit, hipon puti, talakitok, lumot, bisugo, lapad, kabase, chabeta, labahita, dalangang bukid, and others. More specifically, five (5) brokers were reported with supplies of medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) sourced from Zambales.
- Meanwhile, unloading of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki remained sufficient at Navotas Fish Port this week sourced from China.
- On other hand, no supply of medium-sized alumahan (*Rastrillegger kanagurta*) was still recorded in Navotas Fish Port this week.
- Steady supplies of medium-sized bangus from Bulacan were also observed in Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. Hence, the recorded wholesale price was sustained at Php140.00/kg. Likewise, stable supplies of medium-sized tilapia was also noted sourced from Batangas.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus -Bulacan
 - Tilapia -Batangas
 - Local Galunggong- Zambales
 - Alumahan- Not available
 - Imported galunggong - Vietnam

Note: Wholesale price data is as of March 12, 2023, as price data from PFDA was not provided within the internal cut off of the covering period of this report.

 (**) - Actual Price - price data collected did not reach the minimum requirement of three (3) samples per commodity per market.
