Remarks/Market Observations	<p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of January:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Ample volume of supplies for fresh marine commodities were noted among the monitored retail markets this month. However, for medium-sized local galunggong (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) and alumahan (<i>Rastrelliger kanagurta</i>), minimal availability were recorded during the 1st to 3rd week of the month despite the lifting of closed fishing season in Northern Palawan last 1 February 2023 and in Visayan Sea last 15 Feb 2023. Abundant supplies for the said commodities were noted during the 4th week of the month. According to fish vendors, expect to have more supplies for local galunggong and alumahan available during the next few weeks as more unloadings will be observed following the lifting of closed fishing season for the two (2) fishery commodities. Nonetheless, other local galunggong variants like "balsa" (<i>Decapterus macarellus</i>) and "burot" (<i>Decapterus kurroides</i>) were noted today. For imported-frozen galunggong, sufficient supplies were still noted among the monitored retail markets this month. Majority of the fish vendors in the retail markets still prefer selling imported-frozen galunggong due to its cheaper price making it easier to sell than local galunggong. As supply of local galunggong still remain adequate but not abundant some vendors look for an alternative commodity like imported-frozen galunggong to augment the supply. There were also other imported-frozen commodities recorded like Atlantic Salmon, Chub mackerel, Squid, Pampano, Moonfish, Indian scad, and Bullet tuna this month. Sufficient volume of supplies for bangus were noted among the monitored markets this month. This resulted to a stable prevailing retail price at Php160-180/kg. Some of the fish vendors, particularly in Galas, Muñoz and Tandang Sora markets prefer selling large-sized bangus due to higher demand from the consumers/buyers. For tilapia, the prevailing retail price increased at Php140-150/kg this month. This may be attributed to the increased in the feeds price in farm production. Also, most of the reported supplies this month were mostly sourced from Batangas resulting to a higher price due to its premium quality and higher taste preference of consumers/buyers. The difference in price was due to the quality of the commodity wherein the lowest prevailing price of Php180.00/kg recorded on the 4th week of the month was in low quality while the highest prevailing price of Php280.00/kg recorded on the third week of the month were sourced directly from Lucena resulting to better quality (in terms of freshness). * <i>Siganus canaliculatus</i> or Malaga (Php160.00-320.00/kg)- lowest prevailing price of Php160.00/kg was recorded in the third week of the month at Commonwealth Market wherein ample supplies was recorded hence the lower price.
