**Remarks/Market Observations:**

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- For fresh marine commodities, minimal but sufficient availability were observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. This could be due to the effects of the occurrence of the full moon on 07 March, wherein small pelagic fishes (i.e., sardines, galunggong, alumahan, and others) tend to disperse and stay at the bottom of the ocean making it harder to catch.
- Adequate supplies of local-fresh galunggong were noted at the Navotas fish port this week. Most of the supplies recorded were small to medium-sized. The actual wholesale price was at Php160.00/kg this week sourced from Zambales.
- The prevailing wholesale price of imported-frozen galunggong remained at Php140.00/kg and its been stable for the past few weeks due to the sufficient supply at the Navotas Fish Port this week. There is still a demand for the commodity as the supply of local galunggong remained ample but not abundant at the fish port.
- The prevailing retail price of medium-sized bangus and tilapia remained at Php140.00 & 160.00/kg and Php110.00/kg as supplies still remain sufficient at the Fish Port.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
  - Tilapia - Batangas
  - Local galunggong- Zambales
  - Alumahan- NA
  - Imported galunggong - China, Vietnam
- Market administrators continue to strictly implement precautionary safety measures in the monitored markets to ensure the consumers and vendors safety and avoid the further spread of highly infectious COVID-19 OMICRON variant in accordance with the General Community Quarantine- Alert Level 1 guidelines. Among these measures are the mandatory wearing of face masks, social distancing and regular schedule of cleaning and disinfection in the markets, and among others.

*Note: Wholesale price data is as of March 4, 2023, as price data from PFDA was not provided within the internal cut off of the covering period of this report.*
