Remarks/Market Observations:		 Despite the ample avaiability of local-fresh galunggong and its variants, supplies of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki remained available at the fish port this week sourced from China. The recorded prevailing wholesale price remained unchanged at Php130.00/kg. This may be due to the steady sup and demand of the commodity in the fish port. For aquaculture commodities (i.e., bangus and tilapia), supplies continued to be sufficient to cater the demand of the buying public. Majority of the supplies of medium-sized bangus were sourced from Bulacan and Pangasinan. Meanwhile, supplies of medium-sized tilapia were chiefly derived from Batangas. Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: a. Bangus -Bulacan, Batangas c. Local Galunggong - Zambales, Batangas, Northern Palawan d. Alumahan- Not available e.
