<p>Remarks/Market Observations</p> <p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of March:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> More supplies of fresh marine commodities were observed among the monitored retail markets this month. This may be due to the following: a.) peak fishing season in the Philippines which usually begins in March. b.) weak presence of Northeast Monsoon or Amihan affecting only the extreme northern portion of Luzon. c.) and continuing fair weather condition in most parts of the country. The prevailing retail price of local-fresh galunggong decreased from Php280.00/kg last February to Php200.00/kg this March due to the abundant supplies recorded among the monitored retail markets this month. According to fish vendors, more and more supplies of local-fresh galunggong were observed in different fishports this month and will continue to come for the coming weeks or months. Most of the available supplies recorded were still small to medium-sized (11-26pcs/kg) sourced mostly from Navotas and Malabon Fish Ports. Also, there were other local galunggong variants like "balsa" (<i>Decapterus macarellus</i>), "babae" (<i>Decapterus russelli</i>) and "burot" (<i>Decapterus kurroides</i>) recorded in some of the monitored retail markets this month. For imported-frozen galunggong, there were still some vendors who were observed selling the said commodities in some of the monitored retail markets (Trabajo, Quinta, Mega-Q, Balintawak, Galas, Pasig) this month despite the available supply of its local variant. Some of the vendors in Trabajo and Quinta prefer selling imported-frozen galunggong due to its larger and uniform size which was preferred by its buyers/consumers. Also, some of the fish vendors prefer selling imported-frozen galunggong due to its cheaper price making it easier to sell. There were also other imported-frozen commodities recorded like chub mackerel, Atlantic salmon, squid, pampano, moonfish, Indian scad, and bullet tuna this month. There is a slight decrease in the prevailing retail price of bangus at Php160.00/kg as most of the supplies recorded were sourced from Bulacan this month. Nonetheless, the volume of supplies remained sufficient and stable to cater the demand from the consumers. Some of the fish vendors, particularly in Galas, Tandang Sora, and Kanning markets prefer selling larger bangus due to its higher demand. For tilapia, there is also decrease in the prevailing retail price at Php130.00/kg as more supplies were noted among the monitored retail markets this month. Most of the supplies were still mostly sourced from Batangas and Pampanga. There is still a Php10-20/kg price difference between live and dead tilapia. Some of the buyers prefer tilapia sourced from Batangas than tilapia sourced from Pampanga due to its premium quality and taste preference of consumers and buyers.
