The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of March:

- 1. Minimal but ample volume of supplies for fresh marine commodities were noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) during first to third week of the month. However, during fourth and fifth week, abundant supplies were unloaded at the said Fish Port. Commodities noted were lapad, dilis, tamban, kabase, dalagang bukid, bisugo, labahita, chabeta, batalay, bolador, matambaka, and others.
- 2. Abundant supplies of local-fresh galunggong lalaki (Decapterus macrosoma) were observed at the Navotas Fish Port following the lifting of Closed Fishing Season at Northern Palawan last February. In addition, this could be due to the fair-weather condition and peak fishing season in the Philippines which usually begins in March. This resulted to a decreased in the prevailing wholesale price of Php160.00/kg this month. Supplies unloaded were mainly sourced from Northern Palawan, Zambales, Quezon Province, Mindoro, and Batangas.

 3. There are still unloadings of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki noted at the Navotas Fish Port throughout the month. According to fish vendors, there is still demand for the

Remarks/Market Observations:

- commodity despite the availability of local galunggong variants in the said fish port. Some of the vendors prefer selling imported-frozen galunggong due to its cheaper price making it easier to sell.
- 4. For bangus, the prevailing wholesale price remained at Php140.00/kg due to the sufficient and stable at the fish port this month. Most of the supplies were still sourced from Pangasinan and Bulacan. Larger size were noted for supplies sourced from Pangasinan.

 5. No changes were noted in the prevailing wholesale price of tilapia at Php110.00/kg due to the sufficient supply at the market. Most of the supplies of tilapia unloaded in
- Navotas Fish Port were still sourced from Batangas.
- 6. Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
- a. Bangus Bulacan, Pangasinan b. Tilapia Batangas
- c. Local-fresh galunggong Northern Palawan, Zambales, Mindoro, Batangas, Quezon Province
- d. Imported-frozen galunggong China, Vietnam
