2. Requesting for the technical specification specifying performance of the required engine as parameter of each specification stating the corresponding performance during bid evaluation of the offered marine engine for the project.

Submit brochure.

Marine engine must be bought from Authorized dealer/ reseller with nationwide service center.

Provision of after sales service (at least 5 years availability of parts) and 1 year warranty.

TWG will conduct postqualification at the shipyard of the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder (LCRB).

Bid Data Sheet 5.3

Contracts similar to the Project shall be:

a. Supply, Delivery and Fabrication of Boat/Shipbuilding of Fiberglass Reinforced Plastic boats (fishing boats, patrol boats, and other types of vessels)

Bidder must have completed a single contract that is similar to this Project, equivalent to at least **fifty percent**

- 1. For this purpose, similar contract shall refer to supply and delivery or manufacturing of fishing boats, speedboats, water patrol craft, naval ships and boats in relation to the SLCC.
- 2. The shipyard must be operating for at least 5 years, with the experience in the construction and delivery of Fiberglass Reinforced Plastic boats/vessel as declared in the SLCC.

Supply, Delivery and Fabrication of fishing boats, patrol boats, and other types of vessels made of Fiberglass Reinforced Plastic.

The BAC shall allow the submission of aggregated contracts within **TEN** (10) years prior to the deadline of the submission and receipt of bids.

For Aggregated Contracts

(50%) of the ABC within FIVE (5) years prior to the deadline of the submission and receipt of bids.

3. Due to Covid-19 and pandemic lockdown which lasted more than 2 years and orders for new boat construction were practically none, and given the relatively substantial scope and cost of the project involving supply and fabrication of various fishing boats that limits the number of potential bidders and defeat the purpose of competitive bidding well as likelihood of failure of bidding. we are respectfully requesting the BAC to consider the following:

In lieu of requiring at least fifty percent (50%) Single Contract of the ABC, to allow bidders that has completed at least two (2) similar contracts within SEVEN (7) years and the aggregate amount should be equivalent to at least Fifty percent (50%) of the ABC of this project.

- If, at the outset and after conducting market research, the Procuring Entity can already determine that imposing the same will likely result to:
- (a) failure of bidding, or (b) monopoly that will defeat the purpose of competitive bidding, the Procuring Entity, in lieu of the above, may require the following:
- a) The bidder should have completed at least two (2) similar contracts and the aggregate contract amounts should be equivalent to at least the percentage of the ABC as required above; and
- b) The largest of these similar contracts must be equivalent to at least half of the percentage of the ABC as required above.

Aside from the regular eligibility requirements indicated, the first envelope shall also contain the following eligibility documents:

 ISO Certification for shipyard management 1. It appears that the Bid Data Sheet under Section III requires bidders to submit and additional eligibility document of ISO Certification for shipyard management.

Rule VII of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulation of Republic Act No. 9184 provides that only the eligibility BFAR will require the ISO certification as required by MARINA as MARINA Circular No. 2019-01

Shipyard must be MARINA Class A or B.

documents for procurement of goods under Section 23.1 thereof required to submitted. Moreover. GPPB issued its Non-Policy Matter Opinion no. 012-2018 dated 13 April 2018 stating that procuring entities cannot include another requirement to identified list eligibility requirements to wit:

Procuring Entities (Pes) prescribed from requiring additional eligibility requirements. For purposes determining the eligibility bidders. only the documents mentioned in Section 23.1 for the procurement of Goods and Infrastructure projects and Section 24.1 for the procurement of Consulting Services of the 2016 IRR of RA 9184. The PE cannot include another requirement to, nor delete any requirement from, the identified list of eligibility requirements. This because the list of minimum eligibility requirements under the 2016 IRR of RA 9184 has already been streamlined alongside the governing principle of government procurement, i.e. streamlined government procurement process. The rationale for this is to allow greater participation, enhance

competition among prospective bidders, and reduce transaction costs." (Emphasis and underscoring supplied).

The removal of the said additional requirements will provide for fair and equal access to all prospective bidders who are qualified and eligible to supply and deliver the goods under the project subject of this letter.

Furthermore, Section 3 of RA 9184 declares that one of the governing principles government procurement is competitiveness bv extending equal opportunity to enable private contracting parties who are eligible and qualified to participate in public bidding. Clearly, the additional eligibility requirement of ISO Certification under ITB Clause 10, Bid Data Sheet Section III of the Bidding Documents should be removed in adherence to the government procurement principle of healthy and competitive bidding.

In view of the foregoing, we respectfully request the removal of the additional eligibility documents of ISO Certification for shipyard management.

2. Adjusting the Shipyard

Registration Certification MARINA to at least Class C, the required facility under Class C of shipyard area capable to build and repair ship, can accommodate a fabrication area, machine shop and assembly area for the above project.

Bid Data Sheet, ITB Clause 10

Aside from the regular eligibility requirements indicated, the first envelope shall also contain the following eligibility documents.

- Design, Plans and drawings must be signed by licensed naval architect and duly certified/ approved by MARINA and local classification society (General Arrangement, Construction Plan. Scantling. Stability calculation, etc.)
- Proven design or prototype design for testing at sea trial during postqualification.

1. The Bid Data Sheet under Section III requires the bidders to submit and include in the first envelope the design, plans and drawings signed by licensed naval architect and duly certified/approved by MARINA and local classification society.

Since we are still ongoing on the bidding process, this causes an additional expense to the bidder.

The Bid Data Sheet under Section III further requires that the proven design or prototype design for testing at sea trial during post-qualification should be included in the first envelope.

We would like to request for clarification on what documents can the bidders provide for the requirement "proven design or prototype design for testing at sea trial during post-qualification".

2. Proven design to be submitted during Post Qualification and

Plans and drawings should be approved by MARINA to be submitted during Bid Opening.

Approval by Local Classification Society to be submitted during Post-Qualification Evaluation.

Proven design or prototype must be made of FRP.

BFAR will require a certification from the Supplier (completion of delivery with satisfactory performance) from their previous similar project.

- Place 1. of Delivery: Delivery and acceptance shall be at the contractor's site facility while during the delivery to various region by the boat recipients the contractor will provide personnel to assist during each navigation until reaching each destination.
- 2. May we clarify if this project has only one (1) time delivery or will you allow the contractor for a partial delivery or per tranche delivery?

The Schedule of Requirements under Section VI requires the delivery of 52 small to medium-sized commercial boats within eight (8) months form receipt of NTP. In our experience, the delivery of fifty-two (52) boats within eight (8) months is not possible.

Based on the pervious project, it takes several months to construct a mould for the 62-footer boat this includes the procurement of the materials needed in constructing the 62-footer fishing boat.

With this, we want to request the Procuring Entity for an additional twelve (12) months extension to provide prospective bidders ample time to procure and

The Acceptance finished units will be at the contractor's facility after sea trials various tests (as per contract) be to conducted with BFAR inspectors (Regional *Inspectors if outside NCR*) and technical personnel.
