

## The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- 1. Sufficient unloading of marine fishery commodities was noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. Among the commodities recorded were dalagang bukid, lapad, salay ginto, loro, torcillo, tulingan, matambaka, gulyasan, tambakol, espada, and others. More specifically, for medium-sized  $local-fresh\ galunggong\ lalaki\ (\textit{Decapterus macrosoma})\ , a dequate\ supplies\ were\ observed\ with\ prevailing\ wholesale\ price\ of\ Php120.00/kg\ on\ 16\ price\ on\ Php120.00/kg\ on\ 16\ pr$ May and 130.00/kg 23 May 2023. Most of the available supplies in the fish port today were small-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki sourced from Northern Palawan, Zambales, and Quezon Province. Also, other variants of local-fresh galunggong lalaki such as local-fresh galunggong babae (Decapterus ruselli) and burot (Decapterus kurroides) were present.
- 2. For medium-sized imported-frozen galunggong lalaki, seven (7) brokers unloaded the commodity at the fish port with stable prevailing wholesale price of Php130.00/kg on 16 May 2023 and five (5) brokers unloaded the commodity at the fish port with prevailing wholesale price of Php120.00/kg on 23 May 2023. Supplies were imported from China.
- 3. Sufficient unloading of medium-sized bangus was still recorded this week at the fish port. However, supply of large size of the commodity remain the majority of the supplies sourced from Bulacan and Pangasinan. 4. For medium-sized tilapia, supplies at the fish port were obtained from Batangas with recorded prevailing wholesale price of Php100.00/kg on 16
- May and 95.00/kg on 23 May 2023.
- 5. Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
- a. Bangus -Bulacan
- b. Tilapia -Batangas
- c. Local Galunggong- Zambales, Northern Palawan, Quezon
- d. Alumahan- Not available
- e. Imported galunggong China

Note: Wholesale price data is as of May 16 & 23, 2023, as price data from PFDA was not provided within the internal cut off of the covering period of this
