<p><b>Remarks/Market Observations</b></p> <p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of May:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Still, sufficient supplies of fresh marine commodities were recorded among the monitored retail markets on the third and fourth week of the month. On the other hand, lesser volume of supplies was noted on the first, second, and fifth week of the month which might be caused by the (a) occurrence of bright moon, wherein fishes tend to go deeper making them hard to catch, (b) presence of Low-Pressure Area (LPA) in the eastern part of Davao City, Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Visayas and Mindanao and (c) presence of Typhoon "Betty" on May 27-June 1, 2023. Nonetheless, adequate supplies of local fresh galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) was noted among the monitored retail markets sourced mainly from Navotas and Malabon Fish Ports.</li> <li>2. For imported-frozen galunggong lalaki, minimal supplies of the commodity was observed this month. This may be due to the constant availability of local galunggong lalaki and its variants in the monitored markets.</li> <li>3. Availability of alumahan remained sufficient in the monitored retail markets. However, majority of the display was observed to be large-sized sourced from Lucena (Quezon), Malabon, and Navotas Fish Ports.</li> <li>4. Sufficient supply of aquaculture commodities (i.e., bangus and tilapia) were still observed among the monitored wet markets this month. Meanwhile, minimal display of medium-sized bangus was observed as large-sized (1-2pcs/kg) bangus remained to be the majority of displayed sizes in the monitored markets. Supplies were sourced from Pangasinan and Bulacan. Consequently, ample supply of tilapia was still noted chiefly sourced from Batangas.</li> <li>5. Top fishery commodities in the eighteen (18) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan</li> <li>b. Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga</li> <li>c. Local Galunggong - Navotas, Malabon Fish Ports</li> <li>d. Imported Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port</li> <li>e. Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port</li> </ol> </li> <li>6. Fluctuations in the prices of the top fifteen (15) and other commodities are influenced by a number of factors such as the commodity's size, quality, volume of supply, source area, as well as the weather condition and other natural phenomena.</li> </ol> <p>* <i>Alepis djebaba</i> or Salay-salay (Medium) - (Php240.00 - 380.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php240.00/kg was recorded in the second week of the month wherein supply observed is lower in quality as compared to the supplies recorded on the third week of the month which was observed to have better quality in terms of freshness, hence offer relatively higher.</p> <p>* <i>Atule mate</i> or Sa (Small/Medium) - (Php240.00 - 360.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php240.00/kg was noted in the third week of the month wherein supplies were observed to be smaller as compared to the supplies recorded in the fifth week of the month which was observed to be larger size, hence offer relatively higher.</p> <p>* <i>Glossogobius giuris</i> or Bias - (Php200.00 &amp; 420.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php200.00/kg were recorded at Polo Market where supplies were sourced directly from Navotas Fish Port, hence, the lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php420.00/kg was noted at Marikina Market where supplies recorded were in good quality and sourced from a secondary market, hence, the higher price.</p> <p>* <i>Mene maculata</i> or Hiwas - (Php200.00, 300.00, 320.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php200.00/kg was noted in the first and second week of the month wherein supplies were noted low quality in terms of freshness as compared to the supplies which were in good quality recorded on the third and fourth week of the month which observed the highest prevailing price of Php320.00/kg.</p> <p>* <i>Pterocaesio chrysozona</i> or Dalagang Bukid Bilog - (Php240 - 400.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php240.00/kg was noted in the first week of the month wherein supplies were noted smaller as compared to the supplies recorded on the second week of the month wherein larger size was recorded, hence, the higher prevailing price.</p> <p>* <i>Scarus</i> spp. or Loro - (Php80.00 &amp; 180.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php80.00/kg noted in third week of the month are noted smaller size of the commodity, hence offer relatively lower. On the other hand, larger size of the commodity was noted in the fourth week of the month which have recorded the highest price of Php180.00/kg.</p> <p>* <i>Siganus canaliculatus</i> or Danggit - (Php120.00 &amp; 350.00/kg) - both the lowest and highest prevailing retail price were recorded on the first week at Mega-Q Market. The difference in the price were due to the size of the commodity, wherein lowest prevailing price of 120.00/kg was smaller in size and the highest prevailing price of Php350.00/kg was larger in size.</p> <p>* <i>Trichiurus japonicus</i> or Espada - (Php300.00 - 400.00/kg) - Meanwhile, lowest prevailing price of Php300.00/kg noted in the first week of the month was noted low quality in terms of freshness hence offer cheaper as compared to the supplies recorded in the fifth week of the which are noted to have premium quality, hence offer relatively higher.</p> <p>* <i>Upeneus</i> spp. or Saramulyete - (Php150.00-300.00/kg) - both prevailing prices were recorded in the fourth week of the month wherein lowest recorded price of Php150.00/kg was reportedly remaining stocks from the previous markets days, hence offer lower in price.
