Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Sufficient unloading of fresh marine commodities was noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) today. Commodities recorded were tamban, dalagang bukid lapad, pusit kalawang, pusit tunay, bisugo, batalay, and others. More specifically, adequate supplies of medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) was recorded sourced from Northern Palawan with sizes ranging from 8-12pcs/kg at prevailing wholesale price of Php170.00/kg on June 15, 2023. Meanwhile, the recorded prevailing wholesale price decreased to Php100.00/kg (11-20pcs/kg) on June 21, 2023. Price decrement could be due to the varying sizes of unloaded supplies at the fish port.
- For medium-sized imported-frozen galunggong lalaki, supplies remain available at the fish port this week sourced from China.
- On the other hand, unloading of medium-sized alumahan continued to be unavailable this week.
- For aquaculture commodities (i.e., bangus and tilapia), ample supplies were still observed at the fish port this week. As a result, no major changes in the prevailing prices of the said commodities.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus -Bulacan
 - Tilapia -Batangas
 - Local Galunggong- Northern Palawan
 - Alumahan- Not available
 - Imported galunggong - China

Note: Wholesale price data is as of June 15 & 21, 2023, as price data from PFDA was not provided within the internal cut off of the covering period of this report.

(**) - Actual Price - price data collected did not reach the minimum requirement of three (3) samples per commodity per market.
 This could be due to limited volumes or no available supplies at the time of monitoring.
