The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of June:

- Generally, adequate availability of fresh marine commodities were recorded among the monitored retail market this month. On the other hand, lesser supply was noted on the first and fourth week of the month which might be attributed due to the following:
 - The occurrence of full moon on June 4, 2023 which affect the catch of fishermen wherein fishes tend to scatter due to the light from full moon that shines on the sea surface making them hard to catch.
 - Inclement weather condition brought about by typhoon "Betty" noted on the first week and low pressure area on the fourth week of the month resulting to hampered fishing operations.
- Nonetheless, the supplies of local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) remained ample in all monitored retail markets this month. There are also other local galunggong variants like "balsa" (*Decapterus macarellus*), "babae" (*Decapterus russelli*) and "burot" (*Decapterus kurroides*) recorded in some of the monitored retail markets this week.
- Due to the ample supply of local-fresh galunggong this month, minimal display of imported frozen galunggong was observed. Other imported-frozen commodities like pampano, salmon mackarel, pusit kalawang, and tulating were still present in the markets.
- For alumahan, large-sized continued to be evident in most of the monitored wet markets this month. Also, available supply of other variant (i.e., Hasa-hasa) was present chiefly sourced from Malabon Fish Port.
- Adequate availability of bangus and tilapia were still observed in the monitored retail markets throughout the month. Nonetheless, supply of medium-sized bangus remain limited as majority are still large size sourced from Bulacan and Dagupan.
- Top fishery commodities in the eighteen (18) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local Galunggong - Navotas Fish Ports
 - Imported Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port
 - Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port
- Low influx of buyers were still observed among the monitored markets this month. As a result, fish vendors are coping by selling lower volume of supplies and limited varieties of fishery commodities to ensure that all supplies are sold out by the end of the day. Meanwhile, some fish vendors are opening on an alternate day schedule or during market days (Friday-Sunday) where there are more people in the monitored markets.

Meanwhile, highest recorded price of Php250.00/kg noted on the first week of the month is offer in a steaks market form, hence offer in higher price. * <i>Decapterus russelli</i> or Galunggong babae - (Php100.00 & 280.00/kg) - both prevailing price were observed in the fourth week of the month wherein, lowest prevailing price of Php100.00/kg was noted at Pasig Market where supplies recorded were not in good quality (supplies from previous days).
