The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of June:

- 1. Overall, sufficient unloading of fresh marine commodities was noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this month. Commodities recorded were tamban, dalagang bukid lapad, pusit kalawang, pusit tunay, bisugo, batalay, and others. However, lesser supply was observed on the first and fourth week of the month. This could have been due to the following reasons:
- a.) The occurrence of full moon on June 4, 2023 which affect the catch of fishermen wherein fishes tend to scatter due to the light from moon shines on the sea surface making them hard to catch.
 - b.) Inclement weather condition brought about by the effect of Typhoon "Betty".
 - c.) Presence of Low-Pressure Area (LPA) in the east of Eastern Visayas.

Remarks/Market Observations:

- 2. Nonetheless, supplies of local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) was still observed at the fish port this month sourced from Northern Palawan, Zambales, Batangas, and Mindoro.
- 3. Unloadings of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki was also observed at Navotas Fish Port throughout the month. Meanwhile, supply of imported-frozen galunggong babae was only noted at the third week of the month sourced from China.
- 4. Adequate unloadings of aquaculture commodities (i.e., bangus and tilapia), were remain noted at the fish port this month. As a result, the prevailing wholesale price of medium size bangus remain at Php130.00/kg and Php100.00/kg for medium size tilapia.
- 5. Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
- a. Bangus Bulacan
- b. Tilapia Batangas
- c. Local-fresh galunggong Northern Palawan, Zambales
- d. Imported-frozen galunggong China
- -) Price and Volume not available during price monitoring
- (**) Actual Wholesale price data collected did not reach the minimum requirement of three (3) samples per commodity per market. This could be due to limited volumes or no available supplies at the time of monitoring WA-Source Area not available during price monitoring
