The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of July:

- In general, ample supplies of fresh marine commodities were noted among the monitored retail markets for the 1st to 2nd week of this month. However, according to fish vendors, volume of supplies decreased during the 3rd and 4th week of the month due to the continuous rainy weather condition brought by Super Typhoon "Egay" on July 20-27, 2023 and Typhoon "Falcon" on July 29 to August 1, 2023 which hampers the fishing operations of fishermen on affected areas.
- In spite of that, the prevailing retail price of local-fresh galunggong (*Decapterus macrosoma*) remained at Php200.00/kg for this month but increased in the price was noted during the 3rd and 4th week due to the effects of Typhoons "Egay" and "Falcon". According to vendors, supplies for the said commodities were noted to have available display throughout the whole month but were limited during the last two weeks. There are also other local galunggong variants like "balsa" (*Decapterus macarellus*), "babae" (*Decapterus russelli*) and "burot" (*Decapterus kurroides*) recorded in some of the monitored retail markets this month.
- Higher demand were observed for imported-frozen galunggong lakasi during the last two (2) weeks due to the minimal supply of local-fresh galunggong. More specifically, nine (9) retail markets have display on the 4th week compared during the 1st week wherein only one (1) retail market have an available supply. The prevailing retail price have an increasing trend from 3rd to 4th week. Nonetheless, the prevailing price is at Php150.00/kg this month. There were other imported-frozen commodities like pampano, salmon mackerel, salmon head & belly, pusit kalawang, and tulingan still present in the markets.
- For alumahan, the prevailing retail price remained at Php300.00/kg this month. Most of the available supplies were large-sized and were sourced mainly from Lucena and Malabon Fish Port.
- The prevailing retail prices for both bangus and tilapia remained stable at Php160.00/kg and Php140.00/kg this month. According to retail vendors, despite the effects of rainy weather, supplies remained stable and sufficient to cater the demand of the buying public. Majority of bangus reported are still large size sourced from Bulacan and Dagupan. Nonetheless, there is still a Php20-30/kg price difference between live and fresh-chilled tilapia.
- Top fishery commodities in the eighteen (18) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Bulacan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local Galunggong - Navotas Fish Ports, Lucena Quezon
 - Imported Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port
 - Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port
- Low influx of buyers were still observed among the monitored markets this month. As a result, fish vendors are coping by selling lower volume of supplies and limited varieties of fishery commodities to ensure that all supplies are sold out by the end of the day. Meanwhile, some fish vendors are opening on an alternate day schedule or during market days (Friday-Sunday) where there are more people in the monitored markets.
