Remarks/Market Observations:		<p>The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of July:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Generally, adequate unloading of fresh marine commodities were noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this month. Commodities recorded includes salay batang, gulyasan, balsa, salay batang, malasugi, maya-maya, lapu-lapu (itim), espada, hasa-hasa, and others. However, according to vendors, minimal supply was observed during the 3rd and 4th week of the month due to the continuous rainy weather condition brought by Super Typhoon "Egay" on July 20-27, 2023 and Typhoon "Falcon" on July 29 to August 1, 2023 which hampered the fishing operations of fishermen on affected areas. The effects of Typhoon "Egay" and "Falcon" was also noticed in the prevailing wholesale price of local-fresh galunggong wherein higher wholesale price was observed during the last two weeks of the month. According to vendors, limited supplies of local-fresh galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) were observed at the fish port due to the rainy weather condition. Supplies were mainly sourced from Palawan and Zambales. More unloadings of imported-frozen galunggong lalaki were noted at Navotas Fish Port on the last two (2) weeks of the month. This may be attributed to the shift of demand for imported-frozen galunggong wherein higher demand was noted due to the limited supplies of local-fresh galunggong. Meanwhile, imported-frozen galunggong babae continuous to be available at the fish port this month. For medium-sized bangus, no changes were observed in the prevailing wholesale price at Php130.00/kg throughout the whole month due to the stable and sufficient supplies unloaded at the fish port. There is a slight increased in the prevailing wholesale price of tilapia at Php90-105/kg. Higher wholesale price were recorded during the 4th week due to the effects of inclement weather condition. Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga Local-fresh galunggong - Palawan, Zambales Imported-frozen galunggong - Vietnam
