Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Minimal unloading of fresh marine commodities were noted at Navotas Fish Port this week. Commodities recorded were kabase, tamban, turay, tahong, lapad, silinyase, alakaak, labahita, dalagang bukid, and others. This may still be attributed to the effects of Typhoon "Falcon" that brought heavy rainfall and strong winds to the Northern part of the country in the past days. More specifically, for medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), four (4) brokers unloaded the commodity at the fish port on 1 August 2023 with prevailing wholesale price of Php200.00/kg and five (5) brokers on 4 August 2023 at a recorded wholesale price of Php180.00/kg. Supplies were chiefly sourced from Zambales and Northern Palawan.
- Supplies of medium-sized imported-frozen galunggong lalaki from Vietnam continued to be available at the fish port this week with prevailing wholesale price of Php140.00/kg.
- For medium-sized alumahan, one (1) broker unloaded the commodity sourced from Manila Bay at the fish port today. The recorded wholesale price was at an actual of Php180.00/kg.
- Despite the persistent unfavorable weather conditions, supplies of medium-sized bangus from Bulacan, continued to be steady and sufficient at the fish port this week. The recorded prevailing prices were Php135.00 & 140.00/kg (wholesale).
- Similarly, for medium-sized tilapia, adequate volume of supplies was still observed at the monitored wholesale markets this week. Supplies in wholesale were dominantly from Batangas as Region 3 (Central Luzon), primarily Bulacan and Pampanga, was adversely affected by Typhoons Egay and Falcon. In fact, several areas in Central Luzon were flooded hindering the harvests by fish producers. Nevertheless, the recorded prevailing wholesale prices were relatively stable at Php110.00/kg.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus -Bulacan
 - Tilapia -Batangas
 - Local Galunggong- Northern Palawan
 - Alumahan- Not available
 - Imported galunggong - Vietnam

(-) - Price and Volume not available during price monitoring

(**) - Actual Price - price data collected did not reach the minimum requirement of three (3) samples per commodity per market.

This could be due to limited volumes or no available supplies at the time of monitoring.
