**Remarks/Market Observations:**

**The following observations were gathered from market personnel:**

- Overall, sufficient unloading of fresh marine commodities was noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week.
- The prevailing wholesale price of medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) is at Php160.00/kg this week. Minimal volume of supplies were observed today as compared with previous days.
- For imported-frozen galunggong, the supply remained available at Navotas Fish Port this week. The prevailing wholesale price of the commodity was at Php130 & 135/kg imported from Vietnam.
- Same prevailing wholesale prices were noted for bangus and tilapia at Php130.00/kg and Php110.00/kg. This may be attributed to the stable and sufficient supplies at the Navotas Fish Port.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Bulacan
  - Tilapia - Batangas
  - Local galunggong- Zambales, Palawan
  - Alumahan- NA
  - Imported galunggong - Vietnam
