The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- 1. Overall, sufficient unloading of fresh marine commodities was noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week.
- 2. The prevailing wholesale price of medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) is at Php160.00/kg this week. Minimal volume of supplies were observed today as compared with previous days.
- 3. For imported-frozen galunggong, the supply remained available at Navotas Fish Port this week. The prevailing wholesale price of the commodity was at Php130 & 135/kg imported from Vietnam.

Remarks/Market Observations:

- 4. Same prevailing wholesale prices were noted for bangus and tilapia at Php130.00/kg and Php110.00/kg. This may be atrributed to the stable and sufficient supplies at the Navotas Fish Port.
