Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Minimal but sufficient unloading of fresh marine commodities were noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. Among the commodities recorded were dalagang bukid, silinyase, bariles, olpot, bisugo, dilis, loro, gulyasan, tambakol, and others. More specifically, for medium-sized local-fresh galunggong lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), one (1) broker unloaded the commodity from Palawan on 29 August 2023 at the fish port. The recorded wholesale price is at Php180.00/kg.
- For medium-sized imported-frozen galunggong lalaki, supplies continued to be available at Navotas Fish Port at recorded prevailing wholesale price of Php145.00/kg. These supplies were imported from China.
- For medium-sized alumahan, no supplies were unloaded at Navotas Fish Port this week.
- For bangus and tilapia, supplies continued to be evident at Navotas Fish Port with recorded prevailing wholesale prices of Php160.00/kg and Php120.00/kg, respectively.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus -Bulacan
 - Tilapia -Batangas
 - Local Galunggong- Palawan
 - Alumahan- Not available
 - Imported galunggong - China

Note: No Price Monitoring Report were generated on 1 September 2023 due to work suspension caused by the Inclement Weather Condition in the country.

(**) - Actual Price - price data collected did not reach the minimum requirement of three (3) samples per commodity per market. This could be due to limited volumes or no available supplies at the time of monitoring.
