Remarks/Market Observations	<p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of August:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Adequate supplies of fresh marine commodities were noted among the monitored retail markets during the 2nd and 3rd week of the month. This may be due to the good weather condition. However, during the 1st, 4th and 5th weeks, lesser supplies were observed in all monitored markets due to the continuous rainy weather condition brought by Typhoon "Falcon" on Jul 29-Aug 1 (1st week), Super Typhoon "Goring" on Aug 22-30 (4th week) and Typhoon "Hanna" on Aug 30 to Sep 4 (5th week) which hampers the fishing operations of fishermen on affected areas. Nonetheless, the prevailing retail price of medium-size local-fresh galunggong (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) remained at Php200.00/kg for this month. Higher price was noted during the weeks of continuous rainfall brought by Typhoons which resulted to minimal supplies available in different wholesale markets. There are also other local galunggong variants like "balsa" (<i>Decapterus macarellus</i>), "baba" (<i>Decapterus russelli</i>) and "burot" (<i>Decapterus kurroides</i>) recorded in some of the monitored retail markets this month. Despite the decreased in supplies of local galunggong during the rainy weather on 4th and 5th weeks, same demand for imported-frozen galunggong were still noted in the monitored retail market this month. According to vendors, most of them prefer selling local-fresh galunggong due to higher demand from consumers. The prevailing retail price is at Php150.00/kg this month. There were other imported-frozen commodities like pampano, salmon mackarel, salmon, pusit kalawang, and tulingan still present in the markets. The prevailing retail price of medium-sized alumahan remained at Php300.00/kg this month. According to vendors, supplies remained ample in the monitored retail markets. Available supplies were mostly medium to large sizes and were sourced mainly from Lucena and Malabon Fish Port. For bangus and tilapia, no changes were noted in the prevailing retail prices at Php160-180/kg and Php140.00/kg this month. According to vendors, supplies remained stable and sufficient to cater the demand from consumers despite the effects of typhoons this month. Some of the vendors prefer selling larger size of bangus due to the higher demand from consumers. There is still a Php20-30/kg price difference between live and fresh-chilled tilapia. Top fishery commodities in the eighteen (18) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga Local Galunggong - Navotas Fish Ports, Lucena Quezon Imported Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port Low influx of buyers were still observed among the monitored markets this month. As a result, fish vendors are coping by selling lower volume of supplies and limited varieties of fishery commodities to ensure that all supplies are sold out by the end of the day. Meanwhile, some fish vendors are opening on an alternate day schedule or during market days (Friday-Sunday) where there are more people in the monitored markets. Fluctuations in the prices of the top fifteen (15) and other commodities are influenced by a number of factors such as the commodity's size, quality, volume of supply, source area, as well as the weather condition and other natural phenomena. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * <i>Peneus monodon</i> or Sugpo-small - (Php400.00 & 500.00/kg) - both of the highest and lowest price were noted in Malabon Market wherein supplies observed in the 1st week were recorded to be smaller as compared to the supplies recorded in the second week of the month which was larger size. * <i>Scylla serrata</i> or Alimango - Female - (Php650.00 - 800.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php650.00/kg were recorded in the 4th and 5th week where supplies were sourced directly from difference Fish Port, hence, the lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php800.00/kg was also noted in the 1st week where supplies recorded were in good quality and sourced from a secondary market, hence, the higher price. * <i>Portunus pelagicus</i> or Alimasag (small/medium) - (Php200.00-320.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php200.00/kg were recorded in 4th-5th week where supplies were sourced directly from Navotas Fish Port, hence, the lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php320.00/kg was noted in 1st-2nd week where supplies recorded were in good quality and sourced from a secondary market, hence, the higher price. * <i>Glossogobius giuris</i> or Bias - (Php200.00 & 500.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php200.00/kg were recorded at Polo Market where supplies recorded were not in good quality (supplies from previous days). Highest prevailing price of Php500.00/kg was noted at Pasig Market where supplies recorded were in good quality and sourced from Lucena, Quezon. * <i>Lates calcarifer</i> or Apahap - (Php160.00-350.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php160.00/kg were recorded in the 1st week at Munoz Market where supplies observed was in low quality in terms of freshness (remaining stocks from previous market day), hence the lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php350.00/kg was also noted in the 3rd week at Guadalupe Market where supplies recorded were in good quality and sourced from a secondary market, hence, the higher price. * <i>Leiopatheron plumbeus</i> or Ayungin (Php360.00-800.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php360.00/kg were recorded in the 3rd week at Mandaluyog Market where supplies observed was in low quality in terms of freshness (remaining stocks from previous market day), hence the lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php800.00/kg was also noted in the 2nd week at Marikina Market where supplies recorded were in good quality and sourced from a secondary market, hence, the higher price. * <i>Mullus surmuletus</i> or Salmonete - (Php200.00-440.00/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php200.00/kg was observed in Malabon Central market wherein supply are noted to have low quality in terms of freshness hence offer in a cheaper price. Meanwhile, highest recorded price of Php440.00/kg noted in Marikina market was observed to have better quality in terms of freshness sourced from Lucena. * <i>Pseudorhombus</i> sp. or Dapa - (Php200.00 & 480.00/kg) - lowest recorded price of Php200.00/kg was observed in primary market (i.e., Polo Public Market) wherein supply are usually sourced directly from its nearby wholesale market (i.e., Malabon Fish Port). Meanwhile, highest recorded price of Php 480.00/kg was noted in Guadalupe Public Market which supplies are sourced mainly from primary market (i.e., Farmers market wholesale), hence offer relatively higher. * <i>Stolephorus indicus</i> or Dilis - (Php200.00-300.00/kg) - both of the highest and lowest price were noted in Guadalupe Market wherein supplies observed in the 1st week were recorded to be smaller as compared to the supplies recorded in the second week of the month which was larger size.
