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Remarks/Market Observations:		<p>The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of August:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ample unloading of fresh marine commodities were noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) during 2nd and 3rd weeks of the month. Among the commodities recorded were dalagang bukid, silinyase, bariles, olpot, bisugo, dilis, loro, gulyasan, tambakol, and others. Smaller volume of supplies were noted during the 1st, 4th and 5th weeks. This may be attributed to the continuous rainy weather condition brought by Typhoon "Falcon" on Jul 29- Aug 1, Super Typhoon "Goring" on Aug 22-30 and Typhoon "Hanna" on Aug 30 to Sept 4 which hampered the fishing operations of fishermen on affected areas. 2. Higher prevailing wholesale price for local-fresh galunggong were noted during the weeks of continuous rainfall brought by Typhoons. According to vendors, supplies of local-fresh galunggong lalaki (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) decreased during 4th and 5th weeks. Supplies were mainly sourced from Palawan, GenSan and Zambales. 3. For imported-frozen galunggong, the prevailing wholesale price increased as higher demand were noted this month. According to vendors, the minimal supply of local galunggong brought by the inclement weather condition resulted to shifting of demand to imported-frozen galunggong. Also, imported-frozen galunggong babae was available at the fish port this month. 4. Higher prevailing wholesale prices were recorded for aquaculture commodities like bangus and tilapia this month. Moreover, the highest wholesale price recorded in 5th week of the month wherein continuous rainy weather condition was observed brought by Typhoons. According to vendors, the minimal unloading of fresh marine commodities shifted the demand for aquaculture commodities resulting to a higher price. 5. Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan b. Tilapia - Batangas, Pampanga c. Local-fresh galunggong - Palawan, Zambales, GenSan d. Imported-frozen galunggong - Vietnam
